Comments / Explanations:

Rider K Quilty was indisposed for today's meeting.

RACE 1 – THAI IMPERIAL MDN/CL1 - (1880 METRES)

DEER POACHER – Slow to begin and raced three-wide throughout.

FURTHER NORTH – Over raced in the early stages.

HAMPTON BAY – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider R Tan was reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mount out fully to the line.

ROCKYMOUNTAINHIGH – Jumped awkwardly, shifted out passing the 350 metres carrying STRIKE IMPACT out onto DEER POACHER when there was insufficient room to do so. Stewards advised rider C. Baker to exercise more care when shifting ground outwards.

STRIKE IMPACT – Stewards queried rider E Byrne Burke in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider E. Byrne Burke stated when placing the gelding under pressure at the 600 metres her mount failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor heart rate recovery.

SWEETSOP – Checked off the heels of ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH passing the 1400 metres and commenced to over-race until leaving the 1200 metres.

SILENT LOVE – Stewards queried rider S Carr in relation to the below market performance of the filly. Rider S Carr stated the horse failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be showing signs of an elevated heart rate with poor recovery.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES LIVE BETTING 2YO MAIDEN - (1150 METRES)

FROLAND – Over raced when being restrained passing the 900 metres.

HE'LL ROCK IT – Reared on jumping, steadied off heels when over racing approaching the 800 metres. Trainer L Gray was advised that a warning has been placed on the race manners of the colt.

MUSCLE UP – Was slow to begin and steadied off heels approaching the winning post.

EMPHATIC BEL (NZ) – Jumped out of the barriers bumping with STARNOTE, over raced when being restrained passing the 900 metres. Stewards queried rider C Jordan in relation to the below market performance of the filly. Rider C Jordan stated that in her opinion that the filly has come to the end of its preparation. Trainer G. Stephenson confirmed it is his intentions to now spell the filly.

FEAR THE STING – Over raced approaching the 600m shifted out abruptly onto STEELE MY SUNSHINE and ENCHANTED SPY resulting in both horses being inconvenienced and carried wider on the track. A warning has been placed on the racing manners of the filly. Connections advised the filly would now be spelled.

FLYING TO PARIS – Shifted in approaching the winning post momentarily tightening the running of MUSCLE UP. Rider A. Darmanin was advised to exercise more care in future.

STARNOTE – Bumped at the start, over raced approaching the 600 metres.

STEELE MY SUNSHINE – Checked at the 600m by FEAR THE STING.

TRICKY MIKKI – Hung in near the 800m where it appeared that HE'LL ROCK IT which was over racing, made contact with its hind quarters. The filly was then pulled up near the 600 metres. Rider S. Carr reported the filly's action felt amiss. Stewards on reviewing the official patrol films could see that the filly had taken a number of strides with its off-hind leg in the air. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any

abnormalities. Stewards advised trainer T. Hanson that the filly is required to complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP 3YO MAIDEN - (1150 METRES)

ANONYMOUS SOURCE – Tongue tie adjusted behind the barriers prior to the start.

LACERATE – Raced three wide throughout.

POP A HONDA – Shifted out on jumping carrying out FRYER HILL.

CLEVER JEWEL – Carried wide at the start by FRYER HILL.

CLOVER HILL – Bumped by CLEVER JEWEL shifting out at the start and lost its position.

FRYER HILL – Carried out at the start by POP A HONDA.

ISAFJORDUR – Over raced early and middle stage of the race.

MADAME BENEDICT – Declared a late scratching at 9.00am due to no rider being available.

PAGE – Declared a late scratching at 9.00am due to no rider being available.

RACE 4 –TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT MAIDEN – (1009 METRES)

The start of this race was delayed by two minutes due to rider D Ganderton (LABBY ROCK) requiring medical attention after striking his right leg on the side of the barriers, when his mount was being loaded. He was examined by the on-course doctor and ambulance officers and was cleared to ride.

GREYLING – Slow to begin.

TUFFASK – Jumped awkwardly. Stewards advised trainer R. Hamer that a warning had been placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

GOLD GOWN – Inconvenienced and carried wider at about the 600 metres when carried wider by SECRET VEDO.

LABBY ROCK – Fractious prior to the start. Stewards took no action on the mare's barrier manners after viewing the official patrol films and questioning the trainer and rider.

SECRET VEDO – Hung out approaching the 600 metres and shifted out abruptly shortly after carrying Gold Gown outwards. Stewards spoke with trainer J Blacker in

relation to the race manners of the filly. The filly must complete a satisfactory gallop in the presence of stewards at Longford and has been stood down to a satisfactory trial at Devonport.

RACE 5 –KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP - (1150 METRES)

COEUR DE LYON - Shifted out on jumping, hampering TWO DOLLAR TOM.

TWO DOLLAR TOM – Slow to begin and then tightened for room by COEUR DE LYON shifting out, raced wide throughout.

BELL RINGER BOY – Hung in throughout the home straight, rider unable to ride out fully.

ALPINE BLAST – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1.10pm after it kicked the stall and was found to be lame in the near hind. Trainer J Blacker was advised that a veterinary certificate will be required prior to the next race start.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on ALPINE BLAST be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 1.10PM.

7 cents in the dollar for the win # 1 COUER DE LYON
5 cents in the dollar for the place #1 COUER DE LYON
9 cents in the dollar for the place #6 GEE GEES BUZZ
8 cents in the dollar for the place #7 DAWN EAGLE

STAR COUNTESS – Raced three wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

DADORABLE – Stewards granted permission for rider D Ganderton to ride 1kg over the allocated weight. Held up for clear running on the home turn.

TIDAL – Raced three wide until the 600 metres.

RECOMPENSA – Declared a late scratching at 7.45am due to no available rider.

RACE 6 –DRC MEMBERSHIP BM68- (1150 METRES)

BORDER PROTECTION – Raced three wide throughout.

RING OF HONOUR – Raced four wide throughout.

DON'T BUCKME OFF – Shifted out on jumping carrying JULIUS wider. Was held up for a clear run on the home turn.

REWARD ACHIEVER – Stewards queried the below market performance of the mare. Rider C Jordan stated that she placed the mare under pressure from the 400 metres after tracking JULIUS and this being the second run up from a spell, the mare failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure. However, she also stated that the mare will be better for the run.

DIVISOR – Steadied off heels approaching the 400 metres.

TROJAN STORM – Slow to begin.

LADY JOKER – Commenced to over race near the 900, when being steadied off heels.

RACE 7 – POP UP CAFÉ TASMANIA BM62 HCP - (1650 METRES)

ALWAYS A WINNER – Jumped awkwardly at the start, shifted in bumping with SKILENDRA.

OBVIOUS STEP – Over raced in the early stages of the race, raced wide throughout.

SKILENDRA – Hampered by Irish Shotgun on jumping.

NEEDAREIN – Fractious prior to start and jumped awkwardly, slow to begin.

IRISH SHOTGUN (NZ) – Shifted out on jumping, raced wide throughout.

RACE 8 – GO RACING TASMANIA BM62 HCP - (1350 METRES)

NEED TO BE UNIQUE – Over raced in the early stages, hung in in the home straight.

HOLY DIAMOND – Over raced in the early stages.

PROSECUTOR – Over raced in the early mid stages.

SO I'M DREAMING – Hung in on the home straight.

TASSIE MISS – Over raced in the early stages and raced three wide throughout.

STEFANIDI – Hung in throughout in the home straight, rider unable to ride out.

NINTH ANGEL – Slow to begin, raced three wide throughout.

RACE 9 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN BM76 HCP – (1350 METRES)

ETHICAL DILEMMA – Was carried wider near the 900m when FREELANCER shifted out. Rider L. Annells was reminded of her obligations to ensure she rides her mounts out fully to the finish.

CORONATION KEITH – When queried on below market performance, Trainer/Rider, S Carr advised that the Gelding laid out in the early stages and again entering the home straight and ran on only fairly. S Carr added that today's race was the horses first start at this track which may have been a factor in today's performance.

FREELANCER – Raced three wide from the 800m due to the slow pace.

WELDBOROUGH – Over raced early and middle and had a tendency to hang in, in the home straight.

RACE 10 – CARLTON DRAUGHT BM62 HCP – (1350 METRES)

FIGHTING PHOENIX – Bumped with GEE GEE SILENTNITE which lost its position near the 1200 metres. Upon inquiry it was established FIGHTING PHOENIX had shifted in despite the efforts of its rider resulting in SILENTNITE and FRENCH HEIRESS both being restrained by their riders.

SQUARE DONUT – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

GEE GEE SILENTNITE – Tightened for room and lost its position at the 1200m when FIGHTING PHOENIX shifted in.

NEV'S BOY – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 3.08pm as there was no available rider. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on NEVS BOY be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 3.08pm.

1 cent in the dollar for the win # 6 BERRUTI
4 cents in the dollar for the place # 6 BERRUTI
4 cents in the dollar for the place # 2 HERO OF ROMANI
5 cents in the dollar for the place #3 SQUARE DONUT

FRENCH HEIRESS – Tightened for room and lost its position at the 1200 metres.
