Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – IT'S WHY WE RACE BM76 HCP (1600 METRES)**

SIR SIMON – Raced wide in the early stages of the race.

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer J Luttrell was advised that a veterinary certificate is required prior to trialling or racing again.

SKYWAY STAR – Slow to begin.

RACE 2 – LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

VELOCE AQUILA – Reared on jumping and was slow to begin. Trainer T Mollross was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

ALPINE LEGEND – Jumped outwards at the start bumping with MISS ENTHUSIASM, raced wide throughout.

BROADWAY BABE – Slow to muster early speed, raced wide throughout.

CYCLONE LOUIE – Jumped awkwardly, bumped with WEALLSTUCKATHOME shortly after.

KHARI – Fractious in the barriers, jumped awkwardly at the start.

MISS ENTHUSIASM – Jumped awkwardly at the start, bumped with ALPINE LEGEND shortly after the start, raced wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the mare had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr L Wells, was advised that as this was the mares first bleeding attack and MISS ENTHUSIASM would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

WEALLSTUCKATHOME – Bumped with CYCLONE LOUIE at the start.

TOUGH IMPACT – Over raced early and middle stages of the race.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES MATES MODE MAIDEN (1390 METRES)

ANGELIC AMOUR – Raced wide throughout.

CAMPEAO – Raced four wide throughout. Rider D Pires reported that the gelding laid in for a major part of the race. Laid in entering the home straight when attempting to improve shifted out marginally onto CANDY CRUSHER carrying it out onto JACKJACK. Shifted in under pressure in the home straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

CANDY CRUSHER – Carried wider entering the home straight by CAMPEAO which had shifted out to improve. Laid in, in the home straight.

JACKJACK – Laid in entering the home straight, bumped with CANDY CRUSHER which had laid out, shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

MOVE LIKE JAGGER – Raced three wide throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

HER THOUGHTS – Laid out shortly after the start despite the efforts of its rider.

RAPID EFFECT – Slow to begin. Stewards inquired into the reasons why RAPID EFFECT clipped the heels of ZEWINNA shortly after the start. Stewards found that ZEWINNA checked off the heels of HER THOUGHTS which had laid out despite the efforts of its rider and had shifted in more than anticipated. At the same time that SOUTHERN WIND had shifted in marginally. After viewing the official patrol films and taking evidence from all riders stewards were unable to attribute the blame to any one rider, however all riders were advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

ZEWINNA – Jumped awkwardly, checked over heels of HER THOUGHTS shortly after the start.

RACE 4 – MADELEINE OGILIVE MP BM62 HCP (1600 METRES)

YARRA MASTER – Hung out in the home straight. Rider T Johnstone was advised to exercise care when shifting ground out in the home straight.

AMANCAYA – Stewards queried rider T Baker in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider T Baker stated that it was the first time over the distance and that it had failed to run on in the home straight. Trainer S Brunton advised that the mare would now be spelled.

TIESTO – Steadied off heels of YARRA MASTER which had shifted out approaching the 200 metres.

DEER POACHER – Slow to begin.

LE MONDE DE LUCAS – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

FOUR LETTER WORD – Steadied off heels approaching the 600 metres.

FRENCH HEIRESS – Raced three wide throughout. Change of tactics to be ridden further forward if circumstances permit. Ridden accordingly.

RACE 5 GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS BM62 HCP (1200 METRES)

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – Laid out in the home straight.

WEEKEND WHISKY – Clipped heels soon after the start when DON'TBUCKMEOFF jumped outwards, despite the efforts of its rider. Bumped with THOUGHTS'N'PRAYERS shortly after.

IVORYMAN – Slow to begin, laid in, in the home straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainer S Brunton advised stewards that the gelding would now go for a short spell.

DON'TBUCKME OFF – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after the rider reported that the gelding felt short in its action on route to the barriers. Was passed fit to take its place in the field. Over raced early and middle stages.

THOUGHTS'N'PRAYERS – Bumped with WEEKEND WHISKY shortly after the start.

LAYLOW PLUCK – Jumped awkwardly at the start, raced wide early.

LUCA BRATZI – Over raced middle stages.

HERMAN'S BELLS – Jumped awkwardly at the start, raced wide throughout.

NEED A FLUTTER – Slow to begin.

NEV'S BOY – Stewards queried Trainer J Luttrell in relation to the improved performance. Trainer J Luttrell stated that the preparation in trackwork for the gelding had been reduced and that today's track conditions may have also suited.

RACE 6 – THE MILLS NEW NORFOLK CLASS 1 HCP (1390 METRES)

JUST A TRIBUTE – Raced wide throughout.

RANSOM TRUST – Rider T Johnston pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on 11 occasions prior to the 100 metres. In determining penalty stewards took into account her guilty plea, that it was her first offence under this rule and the number of times the whip was used. After considering penalty stewards fined rider T Johnston the sum of \$250. Rider T Johnston was reminded of her right to appeal.

ZADE'S STORIES – Jumped inwards at the start.

CAPTAIN DAVE – Raced three wide throughout.

SMOKIN' HARD – Over raced early, raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – BEC THOMAS MAYOR OF GLENORCHY BM68 HCP (2100 METRES)

TRAVELLING GIGOLO – Raced three wide early and middle.

COSTERO – Raced three wide middle stages.

NEEDAREIN – Jumped awkwardly and was very slow to begin.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES PUNTER ASSIST BM 76 HCP (1100 METRES)

STREET TOUGH – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

BRINKTOP LAD – Raced three wide throughout.

HEZREDHOT – Raced three wide throughout.

GENERAL

TASMANIAN RACING CLUB 27th MARCH, 2022

Owner Ms Teena Bennett pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR228(b) Conduct detrimental to the interests of racing, with the charge being improper conduct. The particulars of the charge being that Ms Bennett approached Ms R Little in the mounting yard, took hold of her arm, pushing her backwards after the running of race 8 at the Tasmanian Racing Club meeting on the 27th March, 2022. In considering an appropriate penalty, Stewards view breaches of this kind very seriously. In determining penalty stewards took into account her remorse, her record in relation to this rule and her record in relation to the years of involvement in the racing industry. On this occasion stewards believed that a penalty be imposed of a \$1000 fine with \$500 wholly suspended that she does not breach this rule within the next twelve months. Ms Bennett was advised of her right of appeal.

RACE 4 – SECRET VEDO

Trainer Mr J Blacker advised stewards that on returning to the stables it was found that the filly was shin sore and would now be spelled. Stewards advised Mr Blacker that SECRET VEDO must trial satisfactorily, and a veterinary certificate be provided prior to racing again.
