Comments / Explanations:

Rider L Annells was reprimanded under the provisions of AR127(1) for failing to fulfill her riding engagement on GREGORIAN CHANT in race 7 due to flight commitments.

RACE 1 – D.F.C TERRY & ROSEANNE ROLES MEMORIAL CLASS 3 HCP – 1220 METRES

FIGHTING FLOYD – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin, inconvenienced shortly after when RING OF HONOUR shifted outwards and MOSHAMA jumped inwards. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

RING OF HONOUR – Held up for a clear run from the home turn to the 150 metres behind LORD WHITEGATE.

DIVISOR – Raced three wide throughout.

LORD WHITEGATE – Over raced early stages.

MILITARY LAW – Jumped awkwardly at the start, held up momentarily on the home turn to the inside of LORD WHITEGATE which hung in.

MOSHAMA – Raced three wide throughout.

OFF PEAK (NZ) – Stewards queried the apparent improved performance of the mare. Trainer Y Nishitani advised stewards that the mare had entered his stables after a significant spell and this combined with gear changes had resulted in the improvement of today.

RACE 2 – A1 HORSE TRANSPORT MISTY WEATHER MAIDEN – 1620 METRES

JACKJACK – Slow to begin, B Neto was issued with a severe reprimand under AR131(a) careless riding for attempting to take a run approaching the 400 metres to the inside of SILENT LOVE where there was insufficient room to do so. This resulted in JACKJACK crowding KHAN OF KHANS to the inside which brushed the running rail before shifting out. JACK JACK then had to be checked outward making contact with the hindquarters of SILENT LOVE unbalancing that filly. Shortly afterwards JACK JACK had to be checked off heels of the tiring SILENT LOVE. In not taking more severe action stewards took into account that the incident had been compounded by SILENT LOVE tiring and losing ground at this point.

KHAN OF KHANS –Crowded and brushed the rail near the 400 metres.

TUFFASK – Slow to begin

ARCUCCI – Laid in after the start contacting ROSE DE LUNE.

EIGHT MARGARITAS – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin

RAPID EFFECT – Slow to begin

SILENT LOVE – Compounded on the home turn.

ZEWINNA – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 – BRITISH HOTEL MALUA 3YO HCP – 1120 METRES

RICH CLAN –Declared a late scratching at 12.52pm after being kicked behind the barriers and after a pre-race veterinary examination was found to be lame. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to trialling or racing again. All bets on RICH CLAN were ordered to be refunded in full with the following deductions:

1st FAIRY MAGIC 11c Win 7c Place
2nd DAWN EAGLE 7c Place

VETLANDA – Fractious in barriers, warning continued. When queried on the below market performance C Jordan stated that when placing the filly under pressure it failed to respond to her riding and that today's track conditions may not have suited. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which fail revealed a poor recovery rate and an infection on the left side of the head from a previous surgery site. The mare will require a veterinary examination prior to racing again.

FIGHTING STYX – Warning placed on the filly's pre-race manners and for being fractious in barriers.

RACE 4 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS TRUST MAIDEN – 1220 METRES

WAYNE'S ON STRYKE –Slow to begin

GEMGO –Crowded on jumping.

LABBY ROCK –Raced three wide throughout.

MADAME BENEDICT – Slow to begin

PAGE –Jumped awkwardly and inconvenienced by LABBY ROCK shifting out.

SURANGANI –Raced wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed blood in the mouth from a bitten tongue.

SOROLI – Pulled back when being loaded into the gates, reared and briefly broke free from the barrier attendant. A warning has been placed on the barrier manners of the gelding. Shifted outwards on jumping tightening LADY INDY onto GEMGO.

RACE 5 – MUMMA BUZZ INCHGOWER CLASS 1 HCP - 1220 METRES

TWO DOLLAR TOM – Bumped on the home turn.

CHOSEN EAGLE –Shifted outwards on the home turn tightening QUEEN'S THE WORD out onto ISAFJORDUR which bumped with TWO DOLLAR TOM which shifted out making contact with ALPINE BLAST. T Baker was advised that he must exercise more care in future when shifting ground.

SPIRITED TOFF –Steadied off heels from the 600 metres to the 500 metres.

ALPINE BLAST –Bounded on jumping. Bumped on the home turn.

DONNA'S DAY – Late scratching at 1.45pm on veterinary advice. Trainer S Brunton was advised that a veterinary certificate must be provided prior to trialling or racing again. All bets on DONNA'S DAY were ordered to be refunded in full with the following deductions:

1st THELMA 12c Win 10c Place

2nd RECOMPENSA 14c Place

3rd (DEAD HEAT) I'M KRUPT 11c SPIRITED TOFF 14c

I'M KRUPT –Bumped at the start.

ISAFJORDUR –Raced three wide. Bumped on the home turn. When queried on today's performance A Darmanin stated the filly raced greenly, received some pressure on the home turn and may not have handled the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the near hind shoe had been dislodged.

STAR COUNTESS – Bounded on jumping and bumped with I'M KRUPT. When queried on the poor performance today trainer D Keating stated the mare may have resented the addition of the tongue tie. Stewards have placed a warning on the mare for being uncompetitive today.

RECOMPENSA –Slow to begin. Trainer stated that the improved performance today was the result of the resolution of mare's veterinary issues.

QUEEN'S THE WORD –When queried on the poor performance today trainer D Keating stated the mare may have trained off. Stewards have placed a warning on the mare for being uncompetitive today.

RACE 6 – DELORAINE HOTEL DELORAINE CUP – 1450 METRES

NEWHART – Rider reported the gelding failed to respond in the home straight. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate and dehydration.

ALINJER –Slow to begin.

RACE 7 – J.G. PEST CONTROL DARRELL GREEN MEMORIAL BM62 HCP - 1450 METRES

REWARD ACHIEVER –Threw its head in the air on jumping and raced ungenerously throughout.

GEE GEE SILENTNITE –Raced three wide throughout.

STEFANIDI –D Pires reported the mare was slow to responded to his riding entering the home straight however ran on well over the concluding stages.

RACE 8 – BLAIR & SONS SAWMILL GUY NEWITT MEMORIAL 0-62 - 2150 METRES

HOBART –Shifted wider approaching the 1000 metres before shifting in when not fully clear of INDIGO GIRLS which had to be restrained. C Atkinson was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding.

INDIGO GIRLS –Inclined to over race in the middle stages and restrained off the heels of HOBART at the 1000 metres.

DEVONPORT RACING CLUB 12/06/2022

Rider R Tan was reprimanded under the provisions of AR127(1) for failing to fulfill his riding engagement on Nev's Boy in Race 10.

TASMANIAN RACING CLUB 19TH June 2022

Race 2 MISS ENTHUSIASM T Johnstone pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip 9 times prior to the 100 metres. After considering submissions on penalty her licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date to commence midnight 3 July 2022 and expire midnight 10 July 2022.

Race 7 DARGO T Johnstone pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip 10 times prior to the 100 metres. After considering submissions on penalty her licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date to be served concurrently with her previous offence.
