RACE 1 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BM68 HCP (1200 METRES)

KUROSET – Re-saddled behind barriers prior to the start. Stewards spoke with rider C Baker in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider C Baker stated that when placing the mare under pressure it failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with the trainer.

HEZREDHOT – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight, carrying DON'TBUCKME OFF wider.

I'M BACK – Laid in momentarily entering the home straight, rider stopped and straightened his mount.

DON'TBUCKMEOFF – Slow to begin. Steadied off heels of HEZREDHOT approaching the 600 metres.

ENTRAPPED – Shifted out on jumping carrying I'M BACK outwards.

SEGUIMIENTOS – Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

BINGO WAS HISNAMEO – Rider T Baker reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout. Lost ground approaching the 600 metres, approaching the 400 metres bumped with CLOVER HILL which laid in momentarily, resulting in the gelding becoming unbalanced for several strides.

CHI MAZEL – Bumped with WHEELING shortly after jumping, shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

EXPENSIVE MISTAKE – Jumped awkwardly and raced wide throughout, carried wider approaching the 400 metres when GRANDEZZA shifted out to improve.

SWINGAPINGA – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

WHEELING – Jumped awkwardly and was slow out, shifted out bumping with CHI MAZEL, resulting in CLOVER HILL steadying off heels of CHI MAZEL. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have a slow heart rate recovery.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 8.00am due to there being no available rider.

CLOVER HILL – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin, steadied off heels of CHI MAZEL shortly after, bumped with BINGO WAS HISNAMEO about the 400 metres becoming unbalanced for a number of strides.

LABBY ROCK – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin as a result, checked off heels of CLOVER HILL at about the 400 metres.

LEICA STARLET – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 11.22am due to there being no available rider. All monies invested on the mare were ordered to be refunded in full, with the following deductions;

1st - TARKINE EAGLE	6c win	5c place

TENNESSEE BEACH – Raced wide throughout, laid in approaching the 400 metres bumping with CLOVER HILL.

I'M KEEFE – Slow to begin, Rider B Neto pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres. In determining penalty stewards took into account his guilty plea, his record in relation to this rule and the number of times the whip was used. After considering penalty stewards suspended his licence for one Tasmanian race date and a fine of \$250 was imposed. B Neto was reminded of his right to appeal.

TOUGH IMPACT – Raced wide throughout.

GRANDEZZA – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin, beaten in excess of 30 lengths. Trainer advised that the mare would now be retired. A veterinary certificate and satisfactory trial will be required if returned to racing.

RACE 3 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

BUNDY CHASER – Stewards questioned rider T Doyle in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider T Doyle stated that the gelding travelled well to the 700 metres but failed to respond to his riding from then on. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

JACKJACK – Slow to begin and muster early speed.

SOROLI – Raced wide throughout.

A WEE NIP – Bumped with PAGE at the start, over-raced early stages.

FRYER HILL – Raced wide throughout.

KHARI – Blundered on jumping, hung out throughout, shied away from the rail approaching the 300 metres.

PAGE – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with A WEE NIP, laid in near the 200 metres tightening WEALLSTUCKATHOME in onto VELOCE AQUILA. Rider A Darmanin was advised to exercise care.

ROSE DE LUNE – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 10.03am due to there being no available rider. All monies invested on the mare were ordered to be refunded in full, with the following deductions;

1st - ZEWINNA	3c win	2c place
2nd - GONE GLOBAL		6c place
3rd - JACKJACK		5c place

WEALLSTUCKATHOME – Raced wide to the 600 metres, crowded for room approaching the 200 metres when PAGE laid in.

ZEWINNA – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 4 –LADBROKE IT! MDN/CL1 (1600 METRES)

DEER POACHER – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

GOLD CHORUS – Bounded on jumping.

JUST A TRIBUTE – Rider A Darmanin advised stewards that the gelding was off the bridal the entire race. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be coughing. Trainer G White advised stewards that he will now spell the gelding for a few weeks to freshen it up.

CAMPEAO (IRE) – Re-saddled behind the barriers.

RANSOM TRUST – Stewards spoke with trainer S Cotton in relation to the improved performance of the mare. Trainer S Cotton stated that she was happy with the previous run, although the mare had over-raced, and she was expecting an improved performance today.

SMOKIN' HARD – Over-raced approaching the 1200 metres.

STEER FOR LADY – Stewards questioned rider C Baker in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider C Baker stated the mare failed to handle the track conditions and when placing the mare under pressure at the 600 metres it failed to respond to her riding.

RACE 5 LADBROKES MATES MODE BM62 HCP (1400 METRES)

HIGH MAINTENANCE – Raced wide throughout, carried wider approaching the 600 metres by ALINJER.

TAVISPLASH (NZ) – Slow to muster early speed. Stewards spoke with rider D Ganderton in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider D Ganderton stated that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

THE MASTER SPEED – Raced wide throughout.

NEV'S BOY – Disappointed for a clear run entering the home straight.

HERMAN'S BELLS – Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

CAPTAIN DAVE – Raced wide throughout, shifted in under pressure over the final stages.

LE MONDE DE LUCAS – Raced wide throughout. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

FOUR LETTER WORD – Rider A Darmanin reported that his saddle had slipped forward and had put him at a disadvantage throughout the race.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE OPEN HCP (1400 METRES)

BLAZE FORTH – Stewards spoke with rider C Baker in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider C Baker stated that the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure. It was also in her opinion that the gelding may have come to its end of its preparation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery.

ROMARY – Raced wide throughout. Stewards spoke with rider C Jordan in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider C Jordan stated that the mare failed to respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards to follow up.

REWARD ACHIEVER – Slow to begin.

RACE 7 – CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES BM76 HCP (2100 METRES)

TAVIRUN (NZ) – Over raced early and middle stages of the race.

SKYWAY STAR – Slow to begin.

COSTERO – Stewards granted permission for rider B Neto to ride 1kg over the allotted weight.

JOHN'S LAD – Stewards questioned trainer J Luttrell on the improved performance of the gelding. Trainer J Luttrell stated that in his opinion the horse was well weighted today and after a good run at its previous start and that the gelding had worked well during the week, they expected that it would perform well in today's race.

YARRA MASTER – Laid in from the 200 metres and continued to shift in over the concluding stages.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK CLASS 1 HCP (1200 METRES)

ALPINE BLAST – Laid in for a major part of the home straight.

DONNA'S DAY – Tightened at the start when PERKINS jumped outwards and BELLE CADEAU jumped inwards, laid in over the final 100 metres.

SHAMZOU – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with NEUTALIZE, raced three wide throughout.

NEUTRALIZE – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with SHAMZOU.

POWERFUL PEBBLES – Slow to muster early speed.

TOUGH COOKIE – Raced wide throughout.

GENERAL

Trainers T Evans, J Luttrell and G Stevenson were all reprimanded under the provisions of AR65(1) for not producing their horse identification documents on request.

Trainer G White advised stewards that after returning to his stables it was found that that I'M KEEFE had pulled up a little shin sore after it's run.
