Comments / Explanations:

Riders L Annells and F Atkinson were indisposed due to flight delays out of South Australia. Other late rider changes were accepted due to rider shortages for this meeting.

RACE 1 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN MAIDEN 2-Y-O & UP MDN - (1009 METRES)

PROPHET EYES – Raced three wide without cover throughout, laid out in the home straight and when corrected laid in.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Declared a late scratching at 8.09am by order of the stewards due to no rider available.

BUTTERBALL – Stewards granted permission for rider D Ganderton to ride 0.5kg over the allotted weight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected. Trainer J Blacker notified stewards that the horse would now be retired.

GAUDI GIRL – Slow to begin, tightened shortly after the start when hampered by LASSETER'S GIRL which was carried out by BUTTERBALL.

I'M VERY HAPPY – Declared a late scratching at 8.07am by order of the stewards due to no available rider.

SHIM – Rider S Carr was reminded of her obligations to ensure she rides her mounts out fully to the finish.

FIESTY LION – Jumped awkwardly

SLIPSLOPSLAP – Lost off fore shoe near the 1000 metres.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN 2-Y-O & UP - (1650 METRES)

HAMPTON BAY – Raced ungenerously middle stages.

REAL MONSTER – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination after biting its tongue on route to the barriers and was subsequently passed fit to take its place in the field.

THEBOLT – Declared a late scratching at 9.31am by order of the stewards due to no available rider. All monies invested on the gelding were ordered to be refunded in full, with the following deductions.

1st - EIGHT MARGARITAS	5c win 4c place
2nd - POP A HONDA	7c place
3rd - LISKAMM	6c place

ARCUCCI – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 9.29am due to no available rider. All monies invested on the filly were ordered to be refunded in full, with the following deductions.

1st - EIGHT MARGARITAS	14c win 10c place
2nd - POP A HONDA	17c place
3rd - LISKAMM	15c place

EGYPTIAN STRYKER – Commenced to over race approaching the 1200 metres.

EIGHT MARGARITAS – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start, over raced early stages when rider C Jordan attempted to restrain.

LISKAMM – Bumped with LUCE DELL LUNA at the start, held up for clear racing room rounding the home turn.

LUCE DELL LUNA – Connections advised of a change of tactics, to be ridden further forward circumstances permitting. Slow to begin, caught wide early stages. Tactics were unable to be adopted in the early and middle stages.

MADAME BENEDICT – Shifted out on jumping bumping with the hind quarters of LISKAMM

PAGE – Stewards granted permission for rider D Ganderton to ride 0.5kg over the allotted weight. Raced three wide middle stages.

HAMPTON STREET – Declared a late scratching by order of stewards at 10.34am due no available rider. All monies invested on the mare were ordered to be refunded in full, with the following deductions.

1st - EIGHT MARGARITAS	0c win	1c place

RACE 3 – SHEBA SHEETMETAL CLASS 1 HCP - (1150 METRES)

MON CHEVAL (NZ) – When easing down past the post by its rider, the gelding was dismounted by its rider after suspecting the gelding sustained an injury. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding had broken both sesamoids in the right fore and was subsequently humanely euthanized. A post-mortem blood sample was taken.

SCHAUFFELE – Bumped with APOLLO ROCKET on jumping.

GEE GEES SO TRUE – Laid out after the start, over raced early and middle stages approaching the 700m started to over race then made the 600m turn awkwardly.

TWO DOLLAR TOM – Over raced middle stages of the race.

APOLLO ROCKET – Jumped awkwardly and bumped with SCHAUFFELE shortly after, over raced middle stages of the race.

TILTHEREWARSYOU – Jumped awkwardly, raced fiercely approaching the 600m, raced wide throughout, laid in under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 4 – THAI IMPERIAL BM62 – (1150 METRES)

GEE GEES BUZZ – Hung in about the 200 metres and again over the concluding stages.

TROJAN STORM – Shifted out on jumping then tightened when GEE GEES CRICKET shifted in. Steadied off heels at the 900m, shifted out near 800m when not quite clear off GEE GEES BUZZ. Rider C Baker was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. Hung in, in the home straight.

GEE GEES CRICKET – Shifted in on jumping and tightened TROJAN STORM

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – Shifted in approaching 900m when not quite clear of TROJAN STORM. Rider D Ganderton was advised to exercise more caution when shifting ground.

RACE 5 – GREAT NORTHERN CLASS 1 HCP - (1350 METRES)

ALPINE AVIATOR – Tightened and lost position near 1200 metres when tightened to the inside of KLATTEN which had been tighten by ISAFJORDUR despite the efforts of its rider. Inclined to lay in over the concluding stages

OLYMPIC HONOUR – Bumped with ISAFJORDUR at the start. Rider D Pires advised stewards that there was something amiss with the gelding. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which revealed arrhythmia and slow heart rate recovery. Trainer S Brunton was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to trialling or racing again.

SPIRITED TOFF – Fractious in barriers Bumped at 1200 with ALPINE AVIATOR stewards questioned rider D Ganderton on the below market expectations of the gelding Rider D Ganderton stated that the gelding pulled hard throughout the race and when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding.

WANE'S QUEST – Lost its position about the 1200 metres when tightened by KLATTEN despite the best efforts of its rider

ISAFJORDUR – Bumped with KLATTEN at the start, shifted in at the 1200m despite the efforts of its rider. Shifted in onto KLATTEN which in turn shifted in onto WANE'S QUEST and ALPINE AVIATOR. Rider A Darmanin was advised to exercise more care in the future in that stewards were of the opinion he should have taken action sooner than what he had done on this occasion. Laid in, in the home straight.

MISIRLOU – Blindfold not able to be applied due to the horses' manners, Stewards spoke with trainer G Stevenson

KLATTEN – Jumped outwards at the start tightening ISAFJORDUR out onto SHAMZOU. Near the 1250 metres laid in tightening the running of WANE'S QUEST which lost it's position despite the efforts of its rider.

SHAMZOU – Bumped with ISAFJORDUR shortly after the start.

RECOMPENSA- Restrained when placed in restricted room near the 1200m. Rider T Baker advised stewards that it was his intentions to restrain to adopt his position in the run.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES FAST WITHDAWLS BM68 HCP - (1350 METRES)

NEED TO BE UNIQUE – Slow to begin, steadied off heels at the 400 metres when there was in sufficient room to take a run to the inside of POLITICAL, resulting in the gelding brushing the running rail.

UBRIACO – Steadied off heels of WEEKEND WHISKY approaching the 1250 metres, raced three wide without cover throughout, laid in, in the home straight.

BANCA NIP – Slow to begin.

LESNAR – Slow to begin, over raced early and middle stages, raced wide throughout.

WEEKEND WHISKY – Shifted in on jumping onto ASHMANIA which had to be steadied by its rider.

ASHMANIA – Steadied off heels of WEEKEND WHISKY at the start, laid in on the straight.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BM62 HCP - (1880 METRES)

DARGO – Commenced a three wide run at about the 1100 metres. Restrained at the 200 metres off the heels of NEEDAREIN which shifted in abruptly.

SQUARE DONUT – Restrained off heels at about the 1700 metres when PERUN crossed to the rails, commenced to over-race shortly after. Steadied off heels of DARGO at about the 1100 metres when that horse was commencing a three wide move.

NEEDAREIN – Shifted in abruptly at the 200m hampering DARGO which had to be restrained off heels.

CAPTAIN MORGAN (NZ) – Over raced early and middle stages of the race.

RACE 8 – GOODSTONE GROUP BM68 HCP - (1009 METRES)

ASPIRATE – Slow to begin.

SHARMA RAMA – Slow to begin, approaching the 600 metres shifted out marginally and bumped with REBEL FACTOR

ARTUSO – Fractious in barriers.

REBEL FACTOR – Fractious in barriers, raced four wide without cover throughout, approaching the 600 metres bumped with SHARMA RAMA.

TIDAL – Raced three wide without cover throughout.
