Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – LADBROKES 2YO HCP - 1120M**

MIAMI SUN – Rider D Ganderton was harmlessly dislodged on route to the barriers. Tightened at the start between MADJACK and MISS VIVANCE, commenced to over race shortly after. Stewards queried rider D Ganderton on the below market performance of the gelding. Rider D Ganderton stated that when placing the gelding under pressure at the 800 metres it failed to respond to his riding and that it had a tendency to hang in throughout. He also stated that the gelding may have been shin sore. A Post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

OUR INDULGENCE – Over-raced in the early stages.

ELLA EXCEEDS – Blundered at the start and was slow to begin as a result, raced three wide throughout.

MISS VIVANCE – Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MDN/CL1 - 2150M

Delay on correct weight when connections of CAMPEAO the second placegetter wished to view the official photo finish. After viewing correct weight was declared on the judge's numbers.

GOLD CHORUS – Slow to begin

HOBART – Connections advised a change of tactics to be adopted, circumstances permitting and that it was their intentions to have the gelding ridden further forward. Fractious in barriers prior to the start, slow to begin, worked forward and raced three wide throughout. Tactics adopted.

I'M SO COOL – Declared a late scratching at 11.33am on veterinary advice when it was advised that the gelding had nasal discharge. Trainer T Keys was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the next race start. All monies invested on the gelding were ordered to be refunded in full, with the following deductions.

1st - FURTHER NORTH	24c win	17c place
2nd - CAMPEAO		19c place
3rd - STRIKE IMPACT		23c place

CAMPEAO (IRE) – Rider T Baker pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on nine occasions prior to the 100 metres, four more than permitted with a total of 15 overall. When assessing penalty stewards took into account his record in relation to the rule and his guilty plea. Rider T Baker was fined the sum of \$200 and was advised of his right of appeal.

FURTHER NORTH – Rolled in marginally at about the 1700 metres and had to be steadied off the heels of HOBART. Rider S Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(i) in that she used her whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres. In determining penalty stewards took into account her guilty plea and offences under this rule. Rider S Carr was fined the sum of \$100.

HAMPTON BAY – Over raced early and middle stages, steadied off heels at about the 1800 metres.

RACE 3 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN - 1420M

GREYLING – Slow to begin

MULTISANTI – Jumped awkwardly, had a tendency to over-race early and middle stages, raced greenly throughout, bumped with WHEELING near the 1200 metres when shifting in.

THEBOLT – Raced three wide throughout.

UPWARD AND ONWARD – Declared a late scratching at 8.32am by order of the stewards due to no available rider.

WHEELING – Bumped by MULTISANTI near the 1200 metres.

GOLD GOWN – Fractious in barriers. Trainer R Hamer was advised that a warning has been placed on the mare.

LABBY ROCK – Blundered on jumping unbalancing the rider, laid in, in the home straight.

RACE 4 – ARMIDALE STUD BM62 HCP - 1420M

RING OF HONOUR – Raced four wide throughout.

HERO OF ROMANI – When questioned on the apparent improved performance of the gelding rider T Baker stated that he believed coming back in distance and the addition of blinkers may have contributed to the improved performance.

THE BEEKEEPER – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

THE MASTER SPEED – Bumped with TIESTO at the 1200 metres, approaching the 900m made the turn awkwardly and had to be steadied of the heels of ISKRA.

TIESTO – Bumped by THE MASTER SPEED near the 1200 metres and became unbalanced for a stride as a result.

LUCA BRATZI – Bumped with ZEVA ROYALE at the start.

ZEVA ROYALE – Bumped with LUCA BRATZI at the start. Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider A Darmanin stated that the mare failed to respond when placed under pressure and that it was his intentions to be closer than he was able to and that the mare failed to travel throughout. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

KEEPER'S TOUCH – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

RACE 5 – ACCESS HARDWARE 3YO HCP – 1220 METRES

GEEGELUCKYSTAR – Raced wide to the 600 metres.

CHARLIE BUCKET – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

CHOSEN EAGLE – Tightened for room at the 800m causing its rider to brush the rail when BELLE CADEAU raced tight to its outside.

GEE GEE ENUF SPEED – Rider T Johnstone was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) for allowing her mount to shift in at about the 1100 meters when insufficiently clear of BELLE CADEAU.

QUEENBOROUGH FLYER – Held up from the 450 metres to the 300 metres.

BELLE CADEAU – Restrained off heels of GEE GEE ENUF SPEED near the 1100 metres when that horse shifted in, as a result that filly stumbled shortly after. Rider D Parish was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing her mount to race tight to the outside of CHOSEN EAGLE at the 800m, resulting in its rider brushing the rail.

NEED A FLUTTER – Rider L Annells was placed at a disadvantage from the 200 metres to the winning post due to her whip getting caught in the mane of her mount.

FIGHTING STYX – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin as a result. Rider C Baker stated that it failed to respond

RACE 6 – THE EXAMINER NEWSPAPER CLASS 3 HCP – 1220 METRES

I'M BACK – Raced three wide early stages.

UNVANQUISHABLE – Bounded on jumping and was slow to begin

BLUSHED – Bumped at the start with TIDAL.

ENTRAPPED – Rider L Annells reported that her mount hung out throughout.

NEV'S BOY – Declared a late scratching at 7.59am by order of the stewards due to no available rider.

MOSHAMA – Stewards granted permission for rider C Atkinson to ride 2.5kg over allotted weight due to no other riders being available.

STEFANIDI – Stood flat footed at the start and was slow to begin 4/5 lengths. Trainer I Hay was advised that a warning has been placed on the starting manners of the mare. Trainer I Hay advised stewards that the mare would now be retired.

TIDAL – Jumped inwards and bumped with BLUSHED. Stewards spoke with rider T Doyle in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Rider T Doyle stated that the mare failed to back up from last start and failed to handle today's track conditions.

FRENCH HEIRESS – Blundered on jumping. Stewards granted permission for the mare to race without blinkers under the provisions of AR206(2) trainer J Blacker was fined the sum of \$100.

RACE 7 – R.F. FERGUSSON MEMORIAL OPEN HCP – 1220 METRES

GEE GEE SECONDOVER – Over raced approaching 800m turn.

BLAZE FORTH – Over raced approaching the 800m had to be steadied off the heels of GEE GEE LANETT.

MUSIC ADDITION – Raced three wide throughout

JULIUS – Shifted out on jumping carrying BLAZE FORTH wider.

SAVS FINALE – Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride 1.5kg over the allotted weight due to no other riders being available. Had a tendency to over race in the middle stages.

BOOM DOT COM – Slow to begin

GEE GEE LANETT – Hung out from the 800 metres until the 600 metres.

LUCKY LIL – Slow to begin and slow to muster early speed, tailed the field. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RACE 8 – 7TAS OPEN HCP – 1620 METRES

TAVIRUN – Slow to begin.

ROMARY – Had to be restrained momentarily when REWARD ACHIEVER crossed to the rails at about the 1500 metres.

REWARD ACHIEVER – Laid out in the home straight. Rider C Jordan was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of ROMARY about the 1500 metres.

MISS CHARLIE BROWN – Slow to begin

RACE 9 - JKB RACING CLASS 1 HCP - 1620 METRES

Correct weight was delayed for connections of DOONICAN to view the official patrol films with a view of placing an objection against the winner for alleged interference approaching the 100 metres. After viewing the official patrol films connections advised stewards that they would not proceed with an objection and correct weight was declared on the judges' numbers.

DOONICAN(IRE) – Raced three wide throughout.

STARION – Stewards queried rider S Carr in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider S Carr stated that in her opinion she felt something amiss with the gelding's action. Rider S Carr was reminded of her obligations to advise stewards of anything that would affect the performance of her mount in a race in future. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding on the trot coughed on a number of occasions and it was suggested that the gelding be scoped. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

BELL RINGER BOY – Blundered on jumping then shifted in bumping with FRYER HILL. Stewards found rider C Atkinson guilty of a charge under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding being that approaching the 100 metres he allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of DOONICAN, resulting in rider C Baker having to check her mount. Rider C Atkinson's licence to ride in races was suspended for one Tasmanian race date, commencing midnight 30th July, 2022 and to expire midnight the 31st July, 2022. In assessing penalty, stewards too into account, his record under this rule and that the carelessness was in the mid-range. Rider C Atkinson was reminded of his right to appeal.

BAHEERA – Stewards granted permission for rider T Johnstone to claim 1.5kg of her apprentices riding allowance. Near the 1500 metres was contacted on the hind quarters of DOONICAN which had shifted out marginally.

Shifted in approaching the 1500 metres at the same time DOONICAN shifted out. As a result, DOONICAN contacted the hind quarters of BAHEERA. Raced greenly throughout. Stewards advised trainer G Mc Culloch was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare for its racing manners.

DEVONPORT RACING CLUB – 17th JULY 2022.

RACE 7 - R.F.FERGUSSON MEMORIAL OPEN HCP (1220M)

Rider R Tan (PERUN) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift in when insufficiently to do so at about the 1700 metres, resulting in SQUARE DONUT having to be restrained by its rider..

DEVONPORT RACING CLUB – 3rd JULY 2022

RACE 6 - THAI IMPERIAL CLASS 1 HCP (1150M)

Trainer M Ganderton advised stewards that after the below market performance of the gelding at Devonport that he had scratched MASTER SUN from the Tasmanian Turf Club meeting on the 24th July. This was due to having had a number of blood tests taken from the gelding, which on the last occasion showed a low white cell count and that they had now placed the gelding on a course of antibiotics.
