Comments / Explanations:

Rider A Darmanin was indisposed for this meeting, due to commitments in Melbourne.

RACE 1 – CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES MAIDEN - (1100 METRES)

There was a delay on correct weight as connections of SCARDIMALIA wished to view the official photo finish. After viewing stewards declared correct weight on the judge's numbers.

ALITTLEDRINKY – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be shin sore. Trainer T Keys was advised that a vet certificate would be required prior to the next race start.

VIVRE IS THE WORD – Caught wide early.

SCARDIMALIA – Tightened for room as LADY SARAH jumped outwards at the start.

SELKIE – Raced wide throughout. Rider T Johnstone was questioned on the below market performance of the mare, rider T Johnstone stated that after receiving pressure on the home turn the mare failed to respond to her riding.

GALAN – Slow to begin and was slow to muster early speed, shifted out and brushed with ANGELI, which laid in away from VIVRE IS THE WORD as the field raced around the home turn.

RACE 2 – THE MERCURY MAIDEN - (1450 METRES)

Stewards delayed correct weight to view the official patrol films over the final 200 metres. Stewards considered lodging a protest against the winner on behalf of the third-place getter. After viewing the official patrol films Stewards were of the opinion both runners brushed from the 200 metres until just before the winning post, however, Stewards considered the interference insufficient to amend the placings and declined to proceed. Correct weight was given on the Judges numbers.

CORONATION FRANK – Slow to begin. Being a first starter and immature rider G CATANIA was of the opinion the gelding had failed to run on.

STEEL MIST – Slow to begin, raced wide until the 700 metres.

AHZEEZAH – Over raced in the early stages.

FALCULA – Slow to begin.

RACE 3 – PFD FOODS BM60 HANDICAP – (1450 METRES)

ARTUSO – Held up for a clear run from the 200 metres to the 100 metres, off the heels of EXPENSIVE MISTAKE.

RAVAGE – Raced wide throughout.

BERRUTI – Stewards questioned rider S Carr in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Riser S Carr was of the opinion the gelding failed to handle the track. Ms Carr also advised it was the geldings second start on the track and it had failed to handle the track at its previous start. Ms Carr also advised stewards that BERRUTI had lost a tongue tie during the run.

EXPENSIVE MISTAKE – Shifted out abruptly at 1000 metres bumping with HERMAN'S BELLS.

HERMAN'S BELLS – Raced wide throughout, bumped by EXPENSIVE MISTAKE at about the 1000 metres.

STELLADONI – Tightened for room shortly after the start between ARTUSO and RAVAGE, laid in from the 200 metres under hard riding.

POWERFUL PEBBLES – Slow to muster early speed. When attempting to improve early in the home straight, shifted out and bumped with EXPENSIVE MISTAKE.

RENASCENCE – Brushed the running rail rounding the home turn.

RACE 4 – PEPPERJACK WINES BM76 HCP – (1450 METRES)

TAVIRUN (NZ) – Raced three wides from the 1000 metres to the 800 metres. When questioned on the below market performance Rider C Wells stated that the gelding failed to respond to her riding from the 400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

ENCOSTA FIORENTE – Steadied when attempting a run between ARGYLE BEACH and TAVIRUN, both shifting ground marginally at the 400 metres.

ARGYLE BEACH – Jumped awkwardly and slow to muster early speed, rolled out marginally approaching the 400 metres.

RACE 5 – MOOD FOOD 0-62 – (1200 METRES)

NICCO THE GREEK – Raced wide throughout, laid in in the home straight, before shifting out under pressure over the concluding stages.

FINXY – Stewards questioned rider G Catania in relation to the below market performance expectations of the gelding. Rider G Catania stated that the gelding would improve by the run as she believes the horse will be better suited over a longer distance.

THE DECIDER – Threw its head in the air at the start and was slow to begin. Shifted out approaching the 200 metres and had to restrain off the heels of NEV'S BOY.

RACE 6 – BEAT THE SHARK BM60 HANDICAP - (1600 METRES)

Delay on correct weight to allow rider B Muchu (BARIA) to view the official photo of the fourth placed dead heating horses. After viewing the official photo Stewards declared correct weight on the judges' numbers.

BANDINELLI – Jumped awkwardly and brushed the inside of the barrier stalls.

LUCKY BUCKY – Was declared a late scratching at 2:10 pm on veterinary advice after the gelding had suffered a laceration to the face whilst on route to the track. All monies invested on the gelding were ordered to be refunded in full with the following deductions.

POPEYE THE SAILOR – Restrained off heels approaching the 700 metres. Stewards questioned rider B McCoull on the below market expectations performance of the gelding. Rider B McCoull stated that it was his opinion the gelding would benefit by the run and will be improved over a longer distance.

WORDS OF PRIDE – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination revealing a small scratch in its nostril.

NEUTRALIZE – Slow to begin.

GEE GEE GOLDENLASS – Raced wide to the 600 metres.

RACE 7 – THA BM68 HANDICAP – (1600 METRES)

ALPINE BLAST – Over raced early and middle stages.

BOND STREET BEAU (NZ) – Slow to begin.
