Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – ROSEVEARS HOTEL ‘SUPPORTING FLINDERS ISLAND’ MAIDEN (1400 METRES)**

AMGELIC AMOUR – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EAGLE STREET – Slow to begin, shortly after was inconvenienced. Near the 1100m had to be steadied when crowded for room by Three’s A Crowd which was taken in by Poet Warrior (A Darmanin) which shifted in when not quite clear. A Darmanin was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding.

NO ACCESS – Crowded at the start and lost ground.

BELPINE MISS – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SIRENE’S LILLY – Over-raced in the early stages.

THREE’S A CROWD - Jumped out at the start.

RACE 2 – ROCKJAW TOURS ‘IT’S WHY WE RACE’ MAIDEN (2) (1400 METRES)

COUP DE SPRY – Slow to begin, commenced to weaken from the 500m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a poor post race recovery.

RUSTIC CHARM – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

OLE OLA – Began awkwardly, hung out throughout.

ROSE DE LUNE – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages.

SMASHING HIT – Raced ungenerously approaching and rounding the first turn.

PINANDI – Raced three wide without cover.

RACE 3 – G & S BUILDERS & PLUMBERS ‘THE UNICORN’ MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

STEEL MIST – Tightened and lost ground at the start, near the 800m had to be steadied when FRYER HILL laid in before being corrected, held up in the early part of the home straight, unable to obtain clear running in the home straight.

FAIRY FLING – Laid in throughout.

FRYER HILL – Hampered at the start, laid in near the 800m.

GEEGEEPOWERPLUS – Rider dropped his whip near the 200m, near the 200m had to be steadied momentarily when awkwardly placed on the heels of ARTFUL PEGASUS (S Carr) which shifted in, whilst under riding.

GOES LIKE THE WIND – Raced greenly throughout.

MILLA’S READY – Began awkwardly.

SELKIE – Jumped out at the start.

ARTFUL PEGASUS – Shifted in about the 200 metres when not fully clear of GEEGEEPOWERPLUS. Rider S Carr was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding.

HATHAWAY – Jumped awkwardly, raced wide and without cover throughout.

RACE 4 – FLINDERS ISLAND CABIN PARK STAR CHEERS BM60 HCP– (1600 METRES)

BARJEEL – Hampered shortly after the start.

ASHMANIA – Bumped on jumping.

NEEDS TOASTING – Raced wide throughout with cover. Shifted in marginally near the 1300 metres when not clear. Rider B McCoull was advised to exercise care.

WELDBOROUGH – Bumped on jumping and became unbalanced, raced ungenerously in the early stages, had to be steadied near the 1300 metres when NEEDS TOASTING (B McCoull) shifted in when not quite clear.

MOSCOW MULE – Slow to begin.

CYCLONE LOUIE – Raced three wide throughout without cover.

SPIRITED TOFF – Bumped on jumping.

THE DECIDER – Bumped on jumping, shifted out on entering the home straight when not fully clear of NORTHERN SPIRIT. Apprentice C Wells was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding.

NORTHERN SPIRIT – Began awkwardly and shifted out bumping another runner, entering the home straight was hampered when THE DECIDER (C Wells) shifted out when not fully clear.

RACE 5 – CUTHILL FAMILY ‘DON’T SLIP THROUGH THE NET’ MDN/CL1 – (2100 METRES)

CHI MAZEL – Stewards queried the below market expectations performance of the gelding, rider S Carr advised that the gelding over raced throughout the middle stages and failed to respond to her riding from the 200m.

GEEGEELOCKDOWN – Jumped awkwardly, raced three wide throughout.

GAYNIK – Over-raced in the early and middle stages

MADAME BENEDICT – Stood flat footed at the start and lost ground.

RACE 6 – INTERSTATE HOTEL FLINDERS ISLAND CUP - (1100 METRES)

Prior to the declaration of correct weight rider B McCoull (MICHBAR) viewed the official patrol footage in the home straight to ascertain if he had grounds to lodge an objection. After viewing the footage, rider B McCoull was satisfied, and correct weight was declared.

OUR LITTLE TED – Laid out when placed under pressure in the home straight.

REWARD ACHIEVER – Declared a late scratching at 4:45pm after a veterinary examination revealed superficial skin wounds to the front legs. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 4:45pm. Trainer G Stevenson was advised a veterinary clearance would be required to the mares next race start.

1 st HANNAH’S SONG	Win 10c Place 16c

MICHBAR – Held up rounding the home turn and in the home straight until about the 100 metres. Stewards questioned rider B McCoull in relation to the below market expectations. Rider B McCoull advised that the gelding requires a more genuine tempo. He further added that when the tempo in the race increased, the gelding was left flatfooted and ran on only fairly.

DUNBRODY POWER –Began awkwardly.

GEE GEE QUEEN BEE – Over-raced in the early and middle stages, raced wide and without cover throughout.

SIRENE STRYKER – Tightened on jumping and lost ground.

HANNAH'S SONG – Began awkwardly and shifted in.

RACE 7 – KILLARA ISLAND WARRIOR BM68 - (1200 METRES)

PEACE BE UPON HIM – Slow to begin.

GEEGEELUCKYSTAR – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Held up in the early part of the home straight and shifted out to obtain clear running.

RACE 8 – MOUNTAIN SEAS LODGE 'THE HIDDEN ZEBRA' CLASS 1 HCP – (1200 METRES)

FIESTY LION – Blundered on jumping and shifted out.

UPSET – Declared a late scratching at 3.40pm after appearing to have skin irritation from being bitten. Trainer D Clark was advised that a veterinary certificate would be required prior to racing. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 3:40pm

1st QUEENBOROUGH FLYER Win 20c Place 11c
2nd PUNK PRINCESS 26c
3rd BYNANCE 24c

BYNANCE – Hampered on jumping.

CHAMPAGNE CINDERS – Declared a late scratching at 9:06pm after refusing to load. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 9:06pm

1st QUEENBOROUGH FLYER Win 11c Place 6c
2nd PUNK PRINCESS 15c
3rd BYNANCE 15c

Trainer J Blacker was advised that the mare will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again. Rider I Toker was checked by Medical Edge attendants and doctor after hitting his ankle in the barriers. Rider I Toker was allowed to fulfil his riding engagements.

TAPPA PASS – Commenced to weaken over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MAGIC TYPHOON – Raced wide and without cover.

PUNK PRINCESS – Began awkwardly. Carried wider on the home turn.

RACE 9 – WHITEMARK POST OFFICE ‘RACING TO FIND A CURE’ CLASS 1 HCP – (1400 METRES)

MONTE BIANCO – Performed below expectations. Rider D Ganderton could provide no explanation in relation to the performance. He further added that in his opinion the mare failed to back up from its last start second on 5th October, 2022. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

TECHNO AWARDS – Slow to begin.

SHAMZOU – Began very awkwardly and lost ground.

PIINK BEAUTY – Shortly after the start was steadied when crowded by MONTE BIANCO (D Ganderton) which shifted in when not fully clear. D Ganderton was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding.

RACE 10 – GLASS WARRIOR ‘AMBASSADOR FOR NETS PLATE’ BM68 HCP - (14400 METRES)

Prior to the declaration of correct weight, rider D Pires (STEEL SKIES) viewed the photo finish. After viewing D Pires was satisfied and correct weight was declared on the judges numbers.

WILLBY RULES – Improved performance queried. Trainer N Schuurin advised that in his opinion the gelding was suited by a more economical run today.
