RACE 1 – ACCESS HARDWARE MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

ANDITWASTHEBEST – Raced wide throughout and the rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout.

VELOCE AQUILA – Raced wide throughout.

VIVRE IS THE WORD – Lost an off fore plate in running near the 800 metres.

DAKOTA PARK – Fractious on jumping and kicked the back gates, raced three wide early.

HATHAWAY – Rolled in near the 400 metres and bumped with ZULU ROSE.

ZULE ROSE – Raced wide throughout. Bumped near the 400 metres by BELLANVIE then shifted out and made contact with Hathaway which had rolled in marginally. Tired over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES EASY FORM MDN/CL1 (2100 METRES)

ALPINE ASSAULT – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

CHI MAZEL – Raced wide throughout. Rider G Catania reported there may be something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be dehydrated.

HAMPTON BAY – Raced wide in the early stages.

POET WARRIOR – Laid in through the home straight.

AMERICAN JEWEL – Raced wide throughout.

PREWINGO – Held up on the home turn.

RUSTIC CHARM – Over raced early, laid in over the concluding stages.

A WEE NIP – Held up near the 400 metres.

MIDNIGHT KISSES – Checked near the 300 metres and held up near the 100 metres. An inquiry into the reasons for MIDNIGHT KISSES being checked near the 300 metres has been adjourned.

RACE 3 – ARMIDALE STUD BM60 HCP (1200 METRES)

GEE GEE TRUE STORY – Shifted out over the concluding stages tightening the running of GEE GEES ROYBOY. C Wells was advised to exercise care when allowing her mount to shift ground.

TRUE SCOTSMAN (NZ) – Raced three-wide throughout.

SCHAUFFELE – Jumped awkwardly, shifted out near the 300 metres tightening GEE GEES ROYBOY which laid in at the same time. Rider D Ganderton was advised to exercise care when shifting out to improve.

WANE'S QUEST – Checked at the start when FEISTY LION shifted in and was slow to begin, raced wide in the early stages.

FEISTY LION – Shifted in abruptly on jumping

TERRACOTTA (NZ) – Slow to begin.

GEE GEE ROYBOY – Tightened on the home turn when SCHAUFFELE shifted out and it laid in.

RACE 4 – LAFM MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

SUPERCRAFT – Laid in over the concluding stages.

HE'LL ROCK IT – Jumped awkwardly and lost ground. Raced ungenerously and shifted in contacting the running rail near the 1000 metres. Hung in from the home turn and could not be ridden out from the 300 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed the colt to be lame in the off fore. Trainer M Ganderton was advised a veterinary certificate would be required prior to trialling or racing again.

AHZEEZAH – Re shod after losing the near hind plate prior to the start. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to compete.

ANGELI – Compounded in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have lumbar soreness. Trainer J Blacker was advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to trialling or racing again.

TRICKY MIKKI – Attempted to buck shortly after the start, raced three wide throughout. The filly has been stood down from racing until it trials satisfactorily.

RACE 5 – JACKSONS SECURITY NEWMARKET HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

THE INEVITABLE – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight when insufficiently clear of TURK WARRIOR which had to be checked. Rider D Pires was found guilty to a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a), the careless riding being that near the 100 metres he permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of TURK WARRIOR resulting in that gelding being checked by its rider. Rider D Pires's licence to ride in races was suspended for two

Tasmanian race dates. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account his plea, his record in relation to this rule, that the carelessness was in the mid-range and that it was a feature race.

NEWHART – A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding revealed a suspensory injury to the near foreleg. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to trialling or racing again.

TURK WARRIOR – Shifted in when not clear of SWOOP DOG near the 800 metres, checked near the 100 metres when THE INEVITABLE shifted in. Rider I Toker was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a), the careless riding being that near the 800 metres, he permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of SWOOP DOG resulting in that gelding being checked by its rider. Rider I Toker's licence to ride in races was suspended for two Tasmanian race dates. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account his plea, his record in relation to this rule, that the carelessness was in the mid-range and that it was a feature race.

MUSIC ADDITION – Checked off heels near the 250 metres when carried out onto the heels of Dark Wanderer. Inquiry adjourned into the reasons why MUSIC ADDITION was checked near the 250 metres.

AND BEYOND – Hampered passing the 250 metres when held up to the inside of DARK WANDERER.

SWOOP DOG – Checked off the heels of TURK WARRIOR near the 800 metres.

DARK WANDERER – Rider advised that she had accidentally dropped her whip at the top of the straight.

ALPINE WOLF – Held up from the home turn until the 150 metres.

RACE 6 – PHIL HUGES OFFICE SOLUTIONS BM60 HCP - (1600 METRES)

ASPIRATE – Became fractious in the barriers and withdrawn from the gates and passed a pre-race veterinary examination. A warning has been issued on the barrier manners of the gelding.

RODRICK'S SECRET – Slow to begin.

BARIA – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to reveal post race cramping.

SECRETLY AWESOME – Over-raced in the early stages.

NORTHERN SPIRIT – Slow to begin.

RACE 7 – BEAT THE SHARK CLASS 1 HCP - (1400 METRES)

LION'S TOOTH – Stewards spoke with rider Ms B Hanham in relation to her shifting out approaching the home turn and bumping with NEEDS TO BELONG. Ms Hanham was advised that she needs to ensure that she exercises greater care when in similar circumstances.

HAPPY CLAN – Bumped with NEEDS TO BELONG at the start.

BLACK EAGLET – Over-raced early and middle stages, raced wide throughout.

GOOD LUCK BOB – Checked after the start when SISTINE shifted out, shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

NEEDS TO BELONG – Bumped with HAPPY CLAN at the start, shifted in near the 200 metres when not fully clear of MISS SLEUTH. Rider D Ganderton was advised to exercise more care.

MISS SLEUTH – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES MARKET CONTROL CLASS 3 HCP – (1400 METRES)

QUEENBOROUGH FLYER – Held up from the 300 metres to the 100 metres for a clear run.

JUST A TRIBUTE – Slow to begin.

SPIRITED TOFF – Began awkwardly and the bumped with QUEENBOROUGH FLYER shortly after. Carried in near the 150 meters when QUEENBOROUGH FLYER SHIFTED in.

OFF PEAK (NZ) – Tightened for room at the 100 metres when SPIRITED TOFF was carried in by QUEENBOROUGH FLYER which had shifted in when held up for clear racing room.
