General:

Rider D Ganderton provided a medical clearance prior to riding at today's meeting.

RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP – (1350 METRES)

NEEDS TO BELONG – Held up home turn behind the tiring BLOW UP. Tightened near the 150 metres. Elected to restrain near the 100 metres and shift to the outside UNIQUE GLOW.

BLOW UP – Trainer R Hamer was advised a warning has been placed on the barrier manners of the mare. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

FROLAND – Slow to begin. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

UNIQUE GLOW – Shifted out near the 300 metres bumping with TECHNO AWARDS and then shifted back in racing tightly to the outside of NEEDS TO BELONG. Shifted in near the 150 metres tightening the running of NEEDS TO BELONG.

TECHNO AWARDS – When questioned on the apparent improved performance trainer P Luttrell advised that it was returning from an injury earlier this year and after the favourable run at the recent TTC meeting he decided to back the horse up today.

MISS SLEUTH – Laid out under pressure at about the 250 metres tightening NEEDS TO BELONG out onto UNIQUE GLOW. Rider C Jordan was advised to exercise more care when her mounts shift ground.

Rider S Carr (Unique Glow) was reprimanded under the provisions AR131(a) - careless riding, for allowing her mount to shift in near the 150 metres when not fully clear of NEEDS TO BELONG, Stewards took into account the horses manners in that it had laid in despite her attempt to straighten.

RACE 2 - CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES MAIDEN - (1350 METRES)

FRANK'S BROTHER – Laid in, in the home straight.

LONDIANI – Over raced in the early stages

SPECIAL INTEREST – Held up on the home turn for a clear run behind GEE GEES FLYBOY.

ARAPTOR – Slow to begin, after being caught wide in the early stages, worked forward.

GRAND PEGASUS – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being momentarily cast over the rail in the outer parade ring and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Slow to begin, over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied. A post race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding was coughing however there were no other abnormalities.

OUR SATURDAY – Slow to begin, saddled slipped at the start.

PUMA – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 - GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN - (1009 METRES)

LAGO APPROACH – A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

WHEELKNOT – Hung in throughout the home straight.

VOLKANOVSKI – Bounded out on jumping, over raced early stages.

LUCE DELLA LUNA – Hung out throughout.

SIRENE'S LILLY – Began awkwardly shifting in and tightening BELLASARIO at the start, over raced early, raced wide throughout.

BELLASARIO – Inconvenienced at the start when SIRENE'S LILLY jumped inwards, over raced early stages.

SNOWBIRD – Hung out and steadied off the heels of VOLKANOVSKI at about the 300 metres.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1650 METRES)

Correct weight was delayed when the rider and trainer of the second placed ANONYMOUS SOURCE viewed the official patrol films and lodged a protest against THREE'S A CROWD being declared the winner alleging interference near the 50 metres. Upon inquiry it was established that THREE'S A CROWD had shifted out abruptly bumping with ANONYMOUS SOURCE which became unbalanced and was carried wider on the track. Stewards were satisfied that the interference had affected the chances of ANONYMOUS SOURCE and exercised their discretion and upheld the protest, with the placings amended accordingly. At a subsequent inquiry Stewards accepted that the interference was due to the racing manners of THREE'S A CROWD.

ANONYMOUS SOURCE – Laid in in the early stages of the home straight. Bumped, became unbalanced and carried wider near the 50 metres.

THREE'S A CROWD – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin, shifted out abruptly near the 50 metres bumping heavily with Anonymous Source. A warning has been placed on the manners of the mare.

GOOGA THE GOAT – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early stages.

KLATTEN – When questioned on the tactics adopted today trainer S.Carr stated that her instructions were for apprentice C Wells to lead on the mare however she may have been further forward than intended.

RACE 5 - LENDING 4 U 0 - 62 - (1150 METRES)

GEE GEE ALS PRINCE – Slow to begin. Rider I Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of [AR132(7)(a)(i)] in that he used his whip in consecutive strides on three occasions prior to the 100 metres. In assessing penalty stewards considered his recent record in relation to the rule and his guilty plea. He was subsequently fined the sum of \$400.00

MADETOBEBROKEN - Slow to be begin

SOULITA – Stewards granted permission for rider C ATKINSON to ride 1kg over the allocated weight. Over raced early, raced wide throughout.

RACE 6 - THAI IMPERIAL BM68 HCP - (1150 METRES)

EASY ROAD (NZ) - Slow to begin.

MICHBAR – A post-race veterinary examination identified the presence of blood in both nostrils. As this was MICHBAR's second episode, trainer A Trinder was advised of the provisions of AR79(6) and that the gelding has been banned from racing for life.

AZARA – Raced wide throughout.

COPPER CHARM – Reared on jumping and was slow to begin by approximately 5 lengths. A warning has been placed on the starting manners of the mare.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES GOLDEN MILE – (1650 METRES)

GLASS WARRIOR – Slow to muster early speed.

SH'BOURNE REBEL – Checked off heels of UBRIACO at the 1400 metres and again at approaching the 600 metres when UBRIACO raced ungenerously and lost ground.

REWARD ACHIEVER – Stewards granted permission for rider D Ganderton to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight of 54kg.

DRAMAZING – Inclined to lay in over the concluding stages.

RISING LIGHT - Shifted out on the home turn and bumped with ALWAYS A WINNER.

TRAVELLING GIGOLO – Held up for a run on the home turn behind the compounding UBRIACO.

UBRIACO – Leaving the home straight first turn and again at the 600 metres raced fiercely became unbalanced and lost ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. A warning has been placed on the racing manners of the gelding.

ARGYLE BEACH – Rider S Carr advised that she lost her inside iron near the 600 metres, momentarily unbalancing the rider when UBRIACO commenced to race ungenerously and hampered her at this point.

BELL RINGER BOY – Stewards granted permission for rider C Atkinson to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Rider C Atkinson was reprimanded under the provisions of AR185 for changing his boots after weighing out.

ALWAYS A WINNER – Over raced early stages and laid in leaving the home straight and had to be steadied by its rider.

RACE 8 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE BM68 HCP – (1350 METRES)

WILLBY RULES - Slow to begin, raced three-wide from the middle stages.

ASSARANCA – Slow to begin.

WARDELL – Raced three-wide throughout. Rider B McCoull advised Stewards that in his opinion there maybe something a miss with the gelding. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

CLIFTON DANSEUR – Lost an off fore plate on route back to the mounting yard after the race. Harmlessly dislodged rider C Jordan on returning to scale. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

NEEDAREIN – Slow to begin, over raced early stages.
