

STEWARDS REPORT

RACE 1 – DON PECK MEMORIAL PACE – 2150 METRES

The start of this race was delayed for 7 minutes due to a gear malfunction necessitating a sulky change on JACKSON NEPTUNE.

STORMY SANZ led and withstood an early challenge for the lead by KIAVINO STRIDE.

KIAVINO STRIDE obtained a trail in the middle stages after racing outside the leader early.

JUNIPER was caught wide early before working forward three wide to race outside the leader.

SMOOTH DEAL NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

HEZ RAZOR SHARP was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 2 – WESTWOOD QUARRY STAKES – 2150 METRES

SOLO SYNC showed gate speed and raced outside the leader early before restraining to a trailing position. The gelding raced roughly for a few strides and then tired to be beaten in excess of 59 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed an upper respiratory condition and the gelding has been stood down until the receipt of a veterinary clearance.

BOLD CENTURIAN was out of position at the start. Driver B Davis was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his barrier position until the start was effected.

GAMEOFCHANCE raced roughly and was out of position at the start. The gelding has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

ALWAYSBEALADY broke as the start was effected and has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

MAEBEE worked forward to race outside the leader throughout.

THEUGLYSISTER broke free of interference and has been stood down for a period of 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

ALKATRAZ was held up behind the tiring SOLO SYNC then tired to be beaten in excess of 62 metres. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 3 – LEIGH & RODNEY PLUNKETT MEMORIAL STAKES – 2150 METRES

IDEAL KARALTA raced outside the leader throughout.

SPORTY BEN was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

CHRISTIAN MAJOR pulled hard during the event.

Driver N Ford (CHRISTIAN MAJOR) was fined the sum of \$200 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a). Particulars were that he used whip with more than a wrist only flicking motion in the home straight.

RACE 4 – HARRY HOLGATE MEMORIAL HEAT TWO – 2150 METRES

WINDY HANOVER was out of position at the start and will continue to be out of the mobile draw.

SHADY STORY led the event before tiring to be beaten in excess of 56 metres and has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

ROAD RUNNER NZ raced outside the leader before obtaining a trail in the middle stages when GALAXY DANCER worked forward three wide to take over that position.

BENJAMIN NIADH and GALAXY DANCER locked wheels briefly around the first turn.

Driver N Ford (CARDINAL SIN NZ) was suspended for a period of two race dates after being found guilty to a charge under AHRR163(1)(b)(i). Particulars were that after racing in a rails position around the first turn he shifted to a one wide position racing into the back straight whilst being covered by the front legs of WINDY HANOVER (R Hillier) forcing that horse to race in a three wide position.

RACE 5 – MORGAN TIMBERS TRAINERS INCENTIVE FINAL – 2150 METRES

BIGLITTLESIS was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader then tired to be beaten in excess 55 metres. A veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities and the mare has been placed on her last chance to race competitively.

Driver G Rattray's (GETHOMEROY) foot slipped from the footrest in the home straight before being immediately replaced.

RACE 6 – PFEIFFER CRANES APPRECIATION PACE – 2150 METRES

SCOTLYNN BEACH NZ jibbed in the score up and was out of position when the start was effected. The gelding has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

Driver J Duggan (KERALA STAR NZ) was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR165(1)(b). Particulars were that around first turn he crossed TISU STORM (G Rattray) who was racing to his inside and had to check slightly. Stewards took into account that Mr Rattray had been easing his horse to take a sit however Mr Duggan crossed to the rails when not a full metre clear.

IM ROCK SOLID worked forward three wide in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

SOUTHSHORE NZ gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 45 metres.

After beginning satisfactorily HICKSTEAD NZ has been reinstated in the mobile draw.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES MEANDER VALLEY CUP – 2650 METRES

Stewards held the all clear on this race to determine the reasons for PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ (N Ford) racing inside several marker pegs around the home turn and if an unfair advantage had been gained by him doing so. It was determined that a full run had become available for PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ to race inside WATTABOUT SPANGHER (A Duggan) prior to the home turn however WATTABOUT SPANGHER had shifted in slightly obliging PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ to race inside the marker pegs before Mr Duggan could relieve the pressure. Stewards were of the opinion that no advantage had been gained and gave all clear on the judges numbers.

DUKE OF DUNDEE NZ was slow to begin.

CHECK IN NZ was slow to begin.

PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ galloped away and has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

LYNRYD SKYNYRD NZ galloped away and has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

MAJOR LESTER underwent a post-race veterinary examination after leading and tiring to be beaten in excess of 43 metres. The examination revealed the gelding to be suffering from the thumps and he has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

RACE 8 – CARRICK INN STAKES – 2650 METRES

ONE OFF NZ broke in the score up and was out of position as the start was effected. The gelding has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

KICK IT TO JACK was inconvenienced in the score up when ONE OFF NZ galloped.

PLEASE SHUDDUP NZ led the event and over raced. A warning was issued to this gelding after hanging in and contacting marker pegs.

WHATTA GOOD REASON underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 65 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

A warning was issued to WHATTA GOOD REASON who hung in and contacted marker pegs when tiring.

N Ford (KICK IT TO JACK) was fined the sum of \$400 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a). Particulars of the charge were that he used his whip with more than a wrist only flicking motion in the home straight.

RACE 9 – MADELEINE OGILVIE STAKES – 1670 METRES

CINOCAL JAMANE broke in the score up and was out of position when the start was effected. The mare has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

ARTYBOY GLENWOOD was restrained after the start.

HOT EMBERS was caught wide early before restraining to a position in the running line.
