Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – W L SHIELDS MAIDEN 3YO & UP – (1100 Metres)

STEEL MIST – Shifted in on jumping bumping with GEEGEESSCARLET BEE, raced wide throughout.

CHEEKY WORD – Raced three wide throughout.

CO ACCUSED – Proved difficult to load rearing on several occasions, a warning has been issued. Crowded on jumping when CORA THE EXPLORER shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

CORA THE EXPLORER – Shifted out on jumping crowding ROYAL SCOTCH out onto MISS NIC NAC.

ROYAL SCOTCH – Crowded on jumping. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

GALAN – Crowded on jumping and lost its position between CO ACCUSED and ELEMJAY which had both shifted ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

GEEGEESSCARLETBEE – Fractious in barriers, bumped with STEEL MIST at the start.

MISS NIC NAT – Bumped on jumping and became unbalanced, raced wide throughout.

RACE 2 - LADBROKE IT! CLASS 1 HCP - (1100 METRES)

EYES FOR ASH – Raced three wide throughout, laid in home straight.

TARKINE EAGLE – Bumped by UPSET soon after the start. Rider H Coffey stated it failed to respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

NINA CARMELLA – Compounded over the concluding stages. Rider C Newitt stated he felt something amiss with the mare's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

UPSET – Jumped very awkwardly, shifted in and bumped with TARKINE EAGLE.

BYNANCE – Held up for clear running on the home turn.

DAWN EAGLE – Held up for a clear run making the home turn.

ELLA EXCEEDS – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Laid in over the final 200 metres.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES MATES MODE BM70 HCP – (1600 METRES)

CHINCHERO – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin. Correct weight was delayed to allow Bulent Muhcu to view the official photo finish. After viewing correct weight was declared on the judges numbers.

SHAMPZ AGAIN – Compounded in the home straight. Rider D Pires stated the gelding failed to respond from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

OLYMPIC HONOUR – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

DIAMOND BAY – An announcement was made the mare would be wearing Winkers and not Blinkers as shown in the race book. Over raced passing the 1400 metres.

RACE 4 – GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS STRUTT STAKES 3YO FILLIES - (2100 METRES)

RISIST CAPTURE –Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 5.10 pm after becoming fractious in the barriers and kicking the back barrier gates. The filly has been stood down from racing until it completes a satisfactory barrier test. All monies invested on RISIST CAPTURE were ordered to be refunded with no deductions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abrasions to both hind legs.

RACE 5 – SCHWEPPE'S TASMANIAN DERBY 3YO – (2100 METRES)

DUNKEL (NZ) –Placed in restricted room and bumped with MIDNIGHT GLOW rounding the home turn. Tightened for room passing the 100 metres when ABRUPT shifted inwards.

MIDNIGHT GLOW – Slow to begin. Bumped with DUNKEL rounding the home turn. Carried wider by ABRUPT approaching the winning post.

CABLE DANCER – Progressed three wide to take up a forward position from the 1300 metres. Bumped when DUNKEL was carried in near the 100 metres.

BERSERKER – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

ABRUPT – Shifted in near the 100 metres under pressure and tightened the running of DUNKEL before being corrected. B McDougall was advised to exercise more care when his mounts shift ground.

UNIQUE GLOW – Over raced near the 1800 metres.

RACE 6 – CARBINE CLUB PLATE 3YO – (1200 METRES)

MIAMI SUN – Raced three wide until entering the home straight where the horse ran wider. Stewards advised apprentice B Hanham that she had erred in her judgment on this occasion and must correct her mounts when they continue to shift ground.

VIBURNUM –Shifted out on jumping and steadied off the heels of MUSCLE UP.

SISTINE – Shifted in on jumping hampering CARTOON GRAVEYARD

BAHIA BAY – Over raced in the early stages. Had to be continually steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres when VIRBURNUM rolled out when not clear when steadying off the heels of MUSCLE UP.

RACE 7 KEVIN SHARKIE BOW MISTRESS GROUP 3 – (1200 METRES)

DANCE TO DUBAI – Rider C Hefel was reprimanded under AR 131(a) Careless Riding for crossing JAJA CHABOOGIE which had to be steadied when not fully clear near the 800 metres, carrying JAJA CHABOOGIE inwards, resulting in JAJA CHABOOGIE commencing to get it's head up and over race.

DUNBRODY POWER – Had to be checked approaching the 800 metres when the pace slackened.

JAJA CHABOOGIE – Steadied near the 800 metres when crossed by DANCE TO DUBIA. Commenced to get it's head up and over race. Steadied approaching the 600 metres off the heels of QUEENBOROUGH FLYER. Held up for a clear run near the 200 metres. Attempted a tight run near the 100 metres and bumped with QUEENBOROUGH FLYER on several occasions. Then held up behind MISS TUPPENCE which had also shifted in. Rider D Pires was advised to exercise care when attempting a tight run. In not taking further action stewards were mindful of the marginal shift inside from QUEENBOROUGH FLYER and MISS TUPPENCE from the outside.

MISS TUPPENCE – Raced three wide throughout.

IN HER STRIDE – Clipped heels near the 800 metres when the pace slackened.

QUEENBOROUGH FLYER – Tightened and unbalanced over the concluding stages when JAJA CHABOOGIE progressed through a tight run.

RACE 8 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 1 HCP – (1400 METRES)

Correct weight was delayed when rider S Carr wished to view the official photo for the dead heat for second. After doing so the placings were confirmed and correct weight declared on the judges numbers.

YANOSHA – Rider L Annells reported that the horse dropped the bit when she moved up to race outside of ETOSHA near the 600 metres and failed to run on over the concluding stages.

ETOSHA – Failed to run on over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

GEE GEE SOX –A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.
