### *Comments / Explanations:*

#### **RACE 1 – SPORTIES HOTEL CUP EVE CALCUTTA MAIDEN 3YO & UP - (1100 Metres)**

**TRUE SOLDIER** – Slow to begin.

**MILLA'S READY** – Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Held up rounding the home turn and entering the home straight. Near the 200 metres had to be steadied when placed in restricted room by GEE GEES DESERT (L Riordan) which shifted out. L Riordan was advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances.

**ENCHANTED SPY** – Raced in restricted room near the 200 metres when CLARA KAREN (I Toker) shifted out to improve. I Toker was advised to exercise more care.

**GEE GEES DESERT** – Attempted to buck on a number of occasions shortly after the start. Team Wells were advised that the filly would be required to trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again.

**GOOGLY** – Declared a late scratching at 9.00am on veterinary advice after Trainer J Flannery advised that the filly had been kicked in the near hind leg during the loading process. Trainer J Flannery was advised a veterinary certificate would be required prior to the fillies next race start.

**NGAPALI BEACH** – Over raced in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

**RACE 2 - LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP 22<sup>ND</sup> FEBRUARY CLASS 1 HCP - (1200 METRES)**

**CHORIZAMA** – Bounded on jumping and was slow into stride as a result. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to suffering from mild colic. The gelding was treated on course.

**DUTCH ACTION** – Began awkwardly and was slow into stride as a result.

**GALLANT WARRIORS** – Raced wide throughout.

**SLIPSLOPSLAP** – Slow to begin.

**ISAFJORDUR** – Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**EGAO** – Held up from the 200 metres until the 100 metres.

**KOOKABURRA** – Near the 900 metres was buffeted between FAKE MAGIC (D Ganderton) which shifted in and ISAFJORDUR (A Darmanin) which shifted out. Shortly after had to be steadied when awkwardly placed in restricted room. D Ganderton was reprimanded for careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a) in that he shifted in when not sufficiently clear. In determining not to take further action against D Ganderton stewards were mindful of the contribution of ISAFJORDUR to the interference near the 900 metres and shortly after.

**RACE 3 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 3 - (1200 METRES)**

**RIGHT HOOK** – Rider B McCoull advised that he had concerns with the gelding's action in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**HAMOGANY** – Inconvenienced on jumping. Slow to begin.

**ALPINE AVIATOR** – Over raced throughout. Near the 900 metres had to be steadied off the heels of OUTBOUND. Near the 600 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels.

**OUTBOUND** – Shifted out on jumping tightening ALPINE AVIATOR.

**SPIRITED TOFF** – Raced wide and without cover throughout.

**ZAGAME** – Raced three wide throughout. Near the 900 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of UNDER HIS EYE (A Darmanin) which shifted in when not clear. A Darmanin was advised to exercise more care.

#### **RACE 4 – CHILLI FM LIVE BROADCAST OAKS DAY BM62 HCP – (1600 METRES)**

**O'REILLY MCLUKE (NZ)** – Bumped on jumping. Raced wide throughout.

**ZEVA ROYALE** – Held up approaching and rounding home turn. Held up near the 100 metres.

**THREE'S A CROWD** – Lost an off fore plate in running. Jumped awkwardly and shifted out.

**FROLAND** – Slow to begin.

#### **RACE 5 – MAGIC MILLIONS 2YO CLASSIC – (1200 METRES)**

**ENCOUNTER SPHERE** – Bumped on jumping.

**BELUGA EXPRESS** – Rider B McCoull reported that the colt raced very greenly throughout and was very reluctant to race to the inside of runners. Laid out rounding the home turn. Performed below market expectation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**JOHNNIE PINCH** – Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**LIBERTY RAY** – Rider T Baker reported that in his opinion the filly failed to run out the 1200 metres of today's event. Stewards will follow up with trainer C Thompson as to the post-race condition of the filly.

**BATCHY BULLET** – Rider D Pires reported that he concerns with the filly's action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**BELLE BLONDE** – Began awkwardly. Apprentice C Baker reported that the filly failed to settle throughout. Beaten a fair distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**LIGHTMEUPJAZZ** – Bumped on jumping, over raced in the middle stages. Stewards granted permission for rider Z Spain to ride 1kg over the allotted weight.

#### **RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN OAKS 3YO FILLIES – (2100 METRES)**

**BADDA BOOM BABY** – Slow to begin. Over raced leaving the home straight on the first occasion. Performed below market expectations. Rider K Latham explained that the filly was disappointing, failed to respond from the 800 metres and that he would recommend to connections for send the filly for a spell. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be recovering poorly.

**AESCULUS** – Over raced and had to be steadied leaving home straight on the first occasion.

## **RACE 7 – MAGIC MILLIONS 3YO/4YO CLASSIC – (1400 METRES)**

**WARICA** – Laid out rounding the home turn.

**EMILY** – Slow to begin.

## **RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE BM68 HCP – (1400 METRES)**

**NAMABAAL** – Performance queried. Rider D Ganderton explained that he had concerns with the action of the gelding shortly after jumping. He added that the gelding travelled on a slow tempo during the middle stages before being forced three wide from the 800 metres. D Ganderton further explained the gelding was not travelling and after appearing to put in an awkward stride rounding the home turn, the gelding was a beaten horse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**GEE GEE CAN WIN** – Raced wide and without cover. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**RING OF HONOUR** – Held up for clear running from the 400 metres until to the 200 metres.

**THE MASTER SPEED** – Resaddled at the barriers. Raced wide in the early stages.
