Comments / Explanations:

Trainer D Keating was reprimanded under the provisions of LR13.3. for late rider declarations for PRINCE OF PASSION in Race 2.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES MATES MODE 2YO MAIDEN - (1120 Metres)

GEE GEES BROTHER – Raced greenly, shifted in near the 600 metres brushing the rail.

IAN'S FINALE – Brushed with HILARITY approaching the 100 metres, becoming momentarily unbalanced.

JOHNNIE PINCH – Hind quarters contacted by RALPH THE ROCKET shifting in upon jumping. Failed to muster early speed. Rider D Pires reported to Stewards that the gelding was reluctant to stretch out throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RALPH THE ROCKET – Jumped awkwardly, striking the inside barrier gate and was slow to begin. Approaching the 300 metres, tightened by SIR JAG which had shifted out. Approaching the winning post shifted in bumping with SIR JAG. Rider L Riordan was reminded to exercise care when allowing his mount to shift ground.

ARUMA – Bumped by HILARITY shortly after the start, raced three-wide throughout.

HILARITY – Shifted out on jumping and bumped with ARUMA. Brushed with IAN'S FINALE near the 100 metres.

MIHOKO TAKEO – Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Rider T Baker reported the filly hung out throughout.

SWINGING IT – Over-raced in the early stages.

SIR JAG – Shifted out at the 300 metres, bumping with RALPH THE ROCKET. Apprentice C Jordan was reminded to exercise care when allowing her mount to shift out.

RACE 2 – SPORTIE'S HOTEL MAIDEN - (1420 METRES)

FRANK'S BROTHER – Inconvenienced at the start when TWINKLEDUST shifted out upon jumping. Raced wide throughout without cover. The gelding compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

NO ACCESS – Raced wide throughout.

PRINCE OF PASSION – Raced wide throughout, compounded from the 400 metres and beaten by a considerable distance. A post-veterinary examination revealed poor respiratory recovery.

SUSHI EXPRESS – Jumped awkwardly at the start.

BAHIA BAY – Rider L Annells reported the gelding hung in near the 800 metres.

TWINKLEDUST – Shifted out abruptly on jumping, hampering FRANKS BROTHER. Was held up from the home turn. Passing the 100 metres rider C Baker shifted out wider to obtain a clear run. Rider C Baker was queried on her tactics adopted from the home turn. Rider C Baker stated she erred in not endeavouring to obtain a run between BOKEO and WEALLSTUCKATHOME near the 300 metres and was then unable to secure a clear run until approaching the winning post. Rider C Baker was advised she should not ride her mounts in a manner that would likely be queried by stewards.

WEALLSTUCKATHOME – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES MARKET CONTROL 0 – 62 - (1420 METRES)

MR FREEZE – Inclined to over race approaching the 800-metre turn. Steadied off the heels of ZADE’S STORIES when it was checked near the 800 metres.

RIGHT HOOK – Steadied momentarily near the home turn when endeavouring to obtain a run on the inside of SPIRITED TOFF.

RAVAGE – At the 1200m was tightened and was forced to ease as GEE GEES RHYTHM shifted in. Approaching the 150 metres the gelding shifted in brushing with SPIRITED TOFF while obtaining a tight run on the inside of GEE GEES RHYTHM.

NEV’S BOY – Slow to muster early speed.

GEE GEE RHYTHM – Raced three-wide throughout. Rounding the 1200 metre turn, WOLF REIN tightened the run of the mare by shifting in, carrying it inwards

SPIRITED TOFF – Was tightened by GEE GEES RHYTHM at the 1200 metre turn.

THE BEEKEEPER – Caught wide early.

ZADE’S STORIES – Restrained near the 1200 metres as SPIRITED TOFF shifted in. Rider G Catania stated she restrained and had clipped heels with SPIRITED TOFF.

Rider L Riordan pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding with the particulars being that he permitted his mount to shift in at about the 1200 metres, tightening the running of GEE GEES RHYTHM in onto SPIRITED TOFF and ZADE’S STORIES, which clipped heels, restrained and lost its position, also resulting in RAVAGE being tightened and easing. Rider L Riordan’s licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of two Tasmanian race dates. In assessing penalty Stewards considered his guilty plea, his riding record in relation to this rule and that the carelessness was in the mid-range.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES SAME RACE MULTI CLASS 1 HCP – (1220 METRES)

BOKEO – Shortly after the start, shifted out carrying STEEL MIST wider.

STEEL MIST – Carried wider shortly after the start. Bumped with ANOTHER PREDICTION rounding the home turn when attempting to improve. Shortly after shifted wider for clear running when not fully clear of ANOTHER PREDICTION. Rider L Annells was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

ISAFJORDUR – Held up inside the 200 metres and was unable to obtain a clear run.

CORONATION VERONIC – Raced three-wide throughout.

DAWN EAGLE – Shifted out. Underwent a post-race veterinary which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

OXY DREAM – Stood flat-footed and missed the start by 8-10 lengths. Trainer C Thompson was advised that the mare was to be stood down to one satisfactory trial.

ELLA EXCEEDS – Fractious in the barrier. A warning was put on the mare’s barrier manners.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Bumped by STEEL MIST when the mare was carried out rounding the home turn.

RACE 5 – GOOD FRIDAY RACING 7TH APRIL 3YO MAIDEN – (1120 METRES)

BUEL – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin

DEVIL SUN – Hung in under pressure passing 200m and again 100m. A post-veterinary examination revealed that the gelding to be exhausted.

BELLASARIO – Over-raced in the middle stages.

DING DING – Over-raced in early and middle stages.

SWOOP THERE IT IS – Shifted in on jumping and was then hampered by CORA THE EXPLORA, causing the filly to lose its position.

TOSEN FAME – Bumped by DEVIL SUN. Shifted out jumping and bumped with CORA THE EXPLORER and blundered severely. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES PUNTERS ASSIST MAIDEN – (1220 METRES)

MYOCARDIUM – Shifted out on jumping, carrying GEE GEES CHORIS wider. Rider L Riordan was advised to exercise care when allowing his mount to shift out at about the 100 metres crowding the running of CHEEKY WORD out over the heels of MILLA'S READY.

CHEEKY WORD – Shifted out at the start hampering SWOOPING EAGLE. Steadied off heels of MILLA'S READY at about the 100 metres.

GEE GEES CHORIS – Raced wide in middle stages. Apprentice C Wells was queried on her riding tactics from the home turn to the finish, rider C Wells stated her horse had a tendency to hang out throughout. Rider C Wells was advised she should endeavour to correct her mount and not allow it to continually shift out in the home straight.

SAVANNAH SLEW – Fractious in barriers, jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced three-wide early. Raced ungenerously throughout. A warning was placed on the mare's barrier manners.

SWOOPING EAGLE – Hampered by CHEEKY WORD shifting out at the start.

MISS PRIVATE – Steadied off the heels of BOBBY BOBBY around the 900 metres.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES SPORTS BAR BM68 HCP – (1220 METRES)

Correct weight was delayed for rider for C Wells to view the official patrol film in relation to her mount being denied a fair start. Stewards were satisfied that the horse had lunged

forward forcing the gates open and as a result lost ground. Correct weight was declared on the judges' numbers.

PRISTINE IMAGE – Lost the near hind pad

GEE GEE LANETT – Lunged forward before the start and contacted the barrier gates, resulting in the mare being slow to begin. The stewards were satisfied that a fair start was enacted. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES SPLIT MULTI'S BM68 – (1420 METRES)

FREAK ON A LEAD – Pre-race vet check at rider's request revealed no abnormalities. Rider G Catania reported that she placed the gelding under pressure from the home turn until the 150 metres, but the horse failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

ALPINE AFFAIR – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RICH CLAN – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

WARDELL – Stewards queried the improved performance. Rider B McCoull stated that the addition of blinkers for the first time along with an inside barrier placing the gelding in a handier position in the field would have assisted.

STELLADONI – Shifted in passing the 200 metres and momentarily held up on the home turn looking for a clear run.

RACE 9 – TASMANIANTURFCLUB.COM MDN/CL1 – (2150 METRES)

AMERICAN JEWEL – Brushed on jumping.

COUP DE SPRY – Slow to begin.

AURUM MAN (NZ) – Slow to begin.

SHAMZOU – Fractious in barriers. A warning was issued on its barrier manners. Over-raced in the straight on the first occasion and the middle stages.

UNIQUE GLOW – Brushed on jumping.

WANING WEASEL – Raced three-wide in the early and middle stages.

ALOTRHONN bumped by MILLA'S READY near the 200 metres which became unbalanced momentarily as a result of MILLA'S READY being placed awkwardly on the heels of NGAPALI BEACH which had been carried wider by GEE GEES DESERT. Rider I Toker was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Race 5 – PFD FOOD SERVICE 3yo CLASSIC – (1200 METRES)

ZULU ANGEL – Held up near the 100 metres.

MIAMI SUN – Tightened on the home turn when ZULU ANGEL rolled out marginally and JAGUAR STONE rolled in, resulting in rider W Costin shifting out over the heels of JAGUAR STONE.

Race 8 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP (2400 METRES)

Stable foreman Mr K Richards advised stewards that on returning to their stables his stable veterinarian examined CREATIVE HERO which was diagnosed with a sore wither.
