Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

AUNTIE JAKE'S BAR – Shifted in under pressure approaching the 100 metres tightening the running of SONTORRE which bumped with ROYAL SCOTCH. Apprentice C Wells was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131(a) for Careless Riding.

CORONATION FRANK – Slow to begin and slow to muster early speed.

FRACASO – Over raced in the early and middle stages, raced wide throughout and laid in under pressure approaching the 200 metres.

JAGGER ROCKS – Tightened on jumping.

MAY WE ALL – Slow to begin.

SONTORRE – Tightened between AUNTIE JAKE'S BAR and ROYAL SCOTCH at the start and laid in bumping with ROYAL SCOTCH.

TRABZON – Shifted out on jumping tightening the running of JAGGER ROCKS.

ALPINE LEGEND – Raced wide throughout.

MISS CHICA MALA – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

ROYAL SCOTCH – Stewards granted permission for rider K Sanderson to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Bumped near the 150 metres when SONTORRE was carried in by AUNTIE JAKE'S BAR.

SCARLETTI – Compounded in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RACE 2 – LADBROKE IT! CLASS 1 HCP – (1200 METRES)

RIGOLETTO (NZ) – Raced wide throughout, carried wider near the 700 metres when PUNK PRINCESS shifted out when over racing. Bumped with PUNK PRINCESS entering the home straight when that mare shifted out. Rider B Hanham had to stop and straighten her mount.

FLYING TO PARIS – Shifted in on jumping hampering BELLASARIO. When questioned on the below market performance rider D Ganderton stated that the filly failed to respond when placed under pressure from the 600 metres.

BELLASARIO – Inconvenienced at the start by FLYING TO PARIS.

NOBLE EXCEPTION – Steadied off heels and over raced near the 600 metres.

BLACK EAGLET – Over-raced in the early stages and again near the 700 metres.

PUNK PRINCESS – Over raced and shifted out near the 800 metres. Raced wide throughout, shifted out entering the home straight bumping with RIGOLETTO NZ. Then RIGOLETTO NZ shifted in bumping that mare.

TARKINE EAGLE – Bounded on jumping, making contact with the inside of the barrier gate.

RACE 3 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN – (1390 METRES)

ARTFUL PEGASUS –Tightened on jumping when FREDDY’S A JETSTAR shifted in and was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – Jumped awkwardly and shifted in tightening ARTFUL PEGASUS.

LONDIANI – Declared a late scratching at 12.06pm on veterinary advice after becoming cast under the front of the barriers. Trainer S Brunton was advised the gelding must trial satisfactorily prior to racing again. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on LONDIANI be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 12.06pm.

Stewards ordered all monies invested on LONDIANI to be refunded in full with the following deductions.

1st - VANITY STAR – 8c win and 10c place
2nd - GLOBAL AWARENESS – 10c place
3rd - FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – 10c place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

Rider G Catania was examined by the on-course doctor and medical staff after injuring her toe in the barriers. Rider G Catania was cleared to resume her riding engagements.

VANITY STAR – Slow to begin.

WADDY WADDY – Over-raced in the early stages, laid in over the concluding stages.

A LITTLE SHADY – The bridle was adjusted behind the barriers prior to the start. Laid in at the start bumping with GLOBAL AWARENESS. Rider D Ganderton reported that the mare felt sore behind and he was reluctant to ride his mount out to the end of the race and eased it down in the home straight. Compounded from the 600 metres, a post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer S Lockhart advised Stewards post-race that the mare had pulled up sore after inspecting the following morning and it was his intentions to now spell the mare.

GLOBAL AWARENESS – Bumped at the start when A LITTLE SHADY laid in. Raced wide throughout, shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK MDN/CL1 – (2100 METRES)

EXPENSIVE MISTAKE – Slow to begin.

HEWIE – Momentarily tightened entering the home straight between EXPENSIVE MISTAKE and KING KURT. When questioned on the below market expectations performance rider B McCoull stated it was the geldings first attempt at the distance and it may not have handled today's track conditions.

POET WARRIOR – Eased out of the race approaching the 600 metres when apprentice Erica Byrne Burke reported she felt something amiss. A post-race veterinary examination

catastrophic muscle tear to the quadricep on the near side hind and the gelding was subsequently humanely euthanised.

BANCA GLEE – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

JUST FOR CURIOSITY – Compounded from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer S Lockhart advised stewards that the gelding appeared to have bled from both nostrils when attending his stables, the following morning. Trainer S Lockhart advised that it was his intentions to now retire the gelding. Stewards advised trainer S Lockhart that the gelding would be stood down from racing under the provisions of AR79(4) for a period 3 months and must gallop 1,000 metres satisfactorily in the presence of Stewards if ever being re-instated prior to racing again.

KING KURT – Laid in entering the home straight.

SAXON MIST – Over-raced in the early stages.

UNNERVING – Rider C Baker reported her saddle slipped passing the winning post on the first occasion placing rider C Baker at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

MISS PEBBLES – Jumped inwards at the start, laid in entering the home straight.

RACE 5 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM72 HCP (2100 METRES)

YARRA MASTER – Apprentice Taylor Johnstone was unable to ride her mount out over the concluding stages after being struck in the face by a clod.

MONMOUTH – Declared a late scratching at 1.22pm on veterinary advice after taking charge and galloping a lap of the course. Stewards advised trainer E Batt that the gelding must complete a preliminary trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to racing again.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on MONMOUTH be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 1.22pm.

Stewards ordered all monies invested on MONMOUTH to be refunded in full with the following deductions.

1st - CHI MAZEL - 8c win and 10c place
2nd - YARRA MASTER - 10c place
3rd - RENASCENCE - 10c place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

EAGLE STREET – Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. When questioned on the apparent below market expectations performance rider David Pires stated the gelding initially didn't respond to his riding at the 600 metres however ran on fairly in the home straight.

CHI MAZEL – Raced wide throughout.

ZADE'S STORIES – Knuckled on jumping.

RACE 6 – CROWNE PLAZA HOBART CLASS 1 HCP – (1390 METRES)

PUNTER – Passed a pre-race veterinary examination after taking charge of the rider in the preliminary and galloping for some distance.

DUMPUS – Raced wide throughout.

SALLY SUNSHINE – Over-raced near the 800 metres, raced wide throughout.

FIGHTING GRACE – Slow to begin and failed to muster any early speed.

AUSSIE BLACK – Compounded from the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RACE 7 – BIG4 ILUKA FREYCINET BM72 HCP – (1390 METRES)

REWARD ACHIEVER – Over-raced in the early stages. Apprentice T Stalker stated that the track conditions and the increase in weight may have been factors in today's performance.

STREET TOUGH – Raced three-wide throughout.

RICH CLAN – Over-raced in the middle stages.

STEEL MIST – Slow to begin.

RAVAGE – Over-raced in the middle stages.

NORTHERN SPIRIT – Over-raced in the middle stages.

GEE GEE SILENTNITE – Over-raced when the pace steadies near the 1000 metres.

RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE BM64 HCP – (1200 METRES)

TONY NICCONI – Apprentice Chloe Wells reported that her mount had not handled today's track conditions. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

HEY BIG SPLENDIA – Tightened between TERRACOTTA and HELLOT on the home turn both of which had shifted ground. Stewards queried rider H McCarthy in relation to the below market expectations of the gelding. Rider H McCarthy stated that the step up in class and the track conditions today may have contributed to the performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow heart rate recovery.

JEREMIAH – Slow to begin.

I'M KRUPT – Shifted out near the 250 metres when insufficiently clear of TERRACOTTA which had to be checked and lost its run.

Rider L Annells pled guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding the particulars of the charge being that at about the 250 metres she allowed her mount to shift out when not fully clear of TERRACOTTA (B Muhcu) resulting in that mare being tightened

and checked. Rider L Annells license to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date to commence on midnight 25th June 2023 and expire midnight 2nd July 2023.

RACE 9 – CAMPBELL TOWN HOTEL MOTEL BM60 HCP – (1600 METRES)

DOONICAN (IRE) – Over-raced in the early stages had to be steadied off heels at the 1200 metres.

AUTISSIER (NZ) – Raced wide throughout.

EIGHT MARGARITAS – Jumped awkwardly.

INDIGO GIRLS – Held up momentarily on the home turn.
