### **RACE 1 – CARLTON & UNITED BREWERIES 3YO HANDICAP – 1620 METRES**

**ARUMA** – Became unbalanced rounding the home turn when bumped on the hindquarters.

**GEEGEE'S DOWN SOUTH** – Rounding the home turn had to be severely checked and lost significant ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**JOHNNIE PINCH** – Hampered at the start. Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**WINNING WITNESS** – Began very awkwardly and shifted in. Over raced throughout. Over raced throughout.

Stewards inquired into an incident which occurred rounding the home turn whereby GEEGEEES DOWN SOUTH was severely checked and ARUMA was bumped and became unbalanced. Upon inquiry, it was established that approaching the home turn, WINNING WITNESS was racing in the three wide line with ARUMA and GEEGEEES DOWN SOUTH to the inside. Shortly after, ARUMA was bumped on the hindquarter and shifted in, bumping GEEGEEES DOWN SOUTH on a number of occasions resulting in both horses becoming unbalanced and rounding the home turn GEEGEEES DOWN SOUTH made contact with the rail, which then lost its position and was severely checked as a result. Stewards determined that no rider was culpable and as such deemed the matter to be a racing incident.

### **RACE 2 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN - 1120 METRES**

**BARATO** – Near the 200m bumped with NEED A GIGGLE. When questioned regarding her vigour rider H McCarthy explained that she received pressure from NEED A GIGGLE approaching the 200 metres and from her previous experience, the gelding had been inclined to lay in when placed under pressure. She further added that she anticipated the gelding rolling in with NEED A GIGGLE. She added that near the 50 metres, in her opinion, the gelding was a beaten horse. She further added that the gelding returned to scale sound in her opinion.

**NEED A GIGGLE** – Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**DEEVIE** – Inconvenienced at the start. Raced fiercely in the middle stages.

**NEED TO THINK** – Over raced in the middle stages. Passing the 100 metres had to be steadied when crowded by NEED A GIGGLE, which laid in.

### **RACE 3 – JACKSON SECURITY TASMANIAN NEWMARKET 29<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER MAIDEN – 1420 METRES**

**ZULU ESPRIT** – Steadied near the 1200 metres. Near the 1100 metres shifted in away from LULULAND, which hung in.

**AL MAXIMUS** – Began awkwardly and bumped with SAKURA HIME.

**LULULAND** – Apprentice B Hanham reported that the mare hung in throughout.

**SAKURA HIME** – Bumped on jumping.

**ELLA DULCIE** – Fractious in the barriers. A warning was placed on record. Began awkwardly. Approaching the 1200 metres had to be steadied.

**KABOOM KABOOM** – Fractious behind the barriers. Trainer B McShane was advised that a warning would be placed on the record of the filly. Stewards also advised Trainer B McShane that in future the filly would be required to proceed to the barriers prior to other runners and have the barrier blanket applied.

**EMMJAY (NZ)** – Change of tactics – to be ridden back. Raced very ungenerously in the early stages. Near the 1100 metres shifted in away from ZULU ESPIRT and had to be steadied. Near the 200m had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels

### **RACE 4 – KREGLINGER CORPORATE MARQUEE BM60 HANDICAP – 1220 METRES**

**I'M BACK** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after dislodging its rider apprentice R Morimoto and galloping riderless for a distance. Passed suitable to start.

**ENCHANTED SPY** – Raced in restricted room rounding the home turn and was steadied momentarily.

**TILTHEREWARSYOU** – Very fractious in the barriers, dislodging its rider K Sanderson. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed suitable to start. Raced wide and without cover. Finished tailed off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer L Gray was advised that the gelding would be required to trial to the satisfaction of stewards on two consecutive occasions owing to its poor record.

**ENSNARE** – Took charge of its rider in the preliminary. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to start.

**WHEELING** – Apprentice E Byrne-Burke dropped her whip passing the 200m.

#### **RACE 5 – SEN PUNTERS MARQUEE BM68 HANDICAP – 2150 METRES**

**MONTE FLEUR** – Unable to be fully tested over the concluding stages when awkwardly placed inside the heels of REWARD FOR ROSIE.

**PAGE** – Slow to begin.

**CAPTAIN MORGAN (NZ)** – Slow to begin.

**REWARD FOR ROSIE** – Over raced in the lead.

**THREE'S A CROWD** – Raced wide and without cover in the early stages. Held up rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

**KNOT DANCING** – Raced wide and without cover. In the early part of the home straight had to be steadied when racing in restricted room. Performance queried. Rider T Baker explained that in his opinion having to make use of its mount from the 600m may have contributed to his mount being left without a finishing effort. He further added that when his mount was racing tight and other runners began to make their run in the home straight, the mare commenced to weaken and was a beaten horse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**INDIGO GIRLS** – In the early part of the home straight had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of KNOT DANCING.

#### **RACE 6 – WORKLOCKER KINGS MEADOWS CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1120 METRES**

Prior to the declaration of correct weight, C Newitt (ROMARY) viewed the patrol footage to ascertain if he had grounds to lodge an objection. After viewing the patrol footage, C Newitt was satisfied, and correct weight was declared.

**SH'BOURNE RENEGADE** – Slow to begin.

**SIR SIMON** – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**ARTY LUCAS** – Hampered on jumping.

**ROMARY** – Over raced in the middle stages. Unable to be fully tested over the concluding stages and steady when awkwardly placed to the inside of SIR SIMON (D Pires), which shifted in under riding. D Pires was reprimanded for careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a).

**Race 7 – McB DEVELOPMENTS 3YO CUP 29<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1420 METRES**

**RICHMOND POET (NZ)** – Began awkwardly and contacted the nearside barrier partition. Raced wide and without cover. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**MIHOKO TAKEO** – Commenced to over race when the pace slackened near the 900 metres.

**EXPENSIVE MISTAKE** – Forced wider when the place slackened near the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be showing signs of a high heart rate and slow recovery.

**ESSEX** – Hampered on jumping.

**RACE 8 – BOOK YOUR XMAS PARTY IN NOW 6<sup>TH</sup> & 13<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 0-60 RATING – 1420 METRES**

**GEE GEE SILENTNITE** – Raced wide and without cover. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled both nostrils for the first time. Team Wells were advised that of the provisions of AR79(8). The gelding has been stood down from racing for a period of 3 months and until the completion of a 1000m gallop in the presence of a steward.

**NEEDS REMEMBERING** – Slow to begin.

**MAARKLE** – Slow to begin. Over raced in the middle stages. Shortly after the winning post had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of ROMANSECO FRESCO (H McCarthy) which shifted in. In assessing the matter, stewards were mindful that there was contribution from MAARKLE, which shifted out onto the heels of ROMANESCO FRESCO. Both riders were advised to exercise more care.
