Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE SCHEME MAIDEN – (1100 METRES)

ALPINE THUNDER – Had a tendency to over-raced early and middle stages.

FRYER HILL – Bumped with STEEL CONNECTION at the start. Slow to muster speed.

LOVE NEST – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to racing Friday 5th April 2024 and was passed fit to race. Over-raced middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

MY DESIGN – Raced wide throughout.

ROSE LEE – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare had a high heart rate and slow recovery.

SHE PLAYS GAMES – Bumped with CORONATION KEELY at the start.

CORONATION KEELY – Jumped out and bumped with SHE PLAYS GAMES. Rider T. Johnstone accidentally dropped her whip at about 250 metres.

GEE GEE DARE – Raced three-wide throughout.

STEEL CONNECTION – Jumped out and bumped with FRYER HILL at the start. Slow to muster speed. Shied away from the rail approaching the 600 metres.

Prior to the declaration of correct weight rider C. Newitt (SHE PLAYS GAMES) wished to view race patrol films. After viewing the films, the correct weight was declared on the judge's numbers.

RACE 2 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN – (1400 METRES)

LET'S MESSAROUND – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

MAY WE ALL – Disappointed for a run approaching the 100 metres to inside of FRENITICO.

TIDEFORD (NZ) – Bumped with LITTLE RIVER TOFF at the start.

LITTLE RIVER TOFF – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being re-plated on the off hind and was passed fit to race. Bumped with TIDEFORD at the start.

NIGHTCLUBBING – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

FRENITICO – Stewards spoke to riders Chelsea Baker and Georgia Catania regarding MAY WE ALL being disappointed for a run inside the 100 metres. Apprentice C. Baker stated that her mount was reluctant to take a run to the inside of FRENITICO. Stewards noted there was a minor shift from FRENITICO. Rider C. Baker stated that she restrained her mount as she had not fully established herself into the run.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN – (1450 METRES)

BUEL – Shifted outwards tightening STEEL RAIDER, GEE GEE TYCOON and MAJOR LAZER.

MAJOR LAZER – Was tightened at the start by BUEL.

NEED A GIGGLE – Jumped in at the start contacting the hindquarter of MAJOR LAZER, unbalancing rider E. Byrne Burke momentarily.

STEEL RAIDER – Jumped out at the start making contact with the outside barrier. Was tightened at the start by BUEL. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which detected lameness in the off foreleg. Stewards advised trainer J. Luttrell the mare will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again. Rider H. LeBlanc was reminded of her obligations under provisions of AR114(2)(a) to report to Stewards anything which might have affected the running of her mounts in a race.

GEE GEE TYCOON – Fractious in barrier. Brushed the inside of the barrier and jumped out. Had a tendency to over-race early and middle stages.

PEPPARONI – Raced three-wide throughout.

RACE 4 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP – (2200 METRES)

NO ACCESS – Raced wide throughout.

COSTERO – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

GEEGEE'S DOWN SOUTH – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected. Rider T. Johnstone advised her mount did not handle today's track conditions.

STEEL MIST – Slow to muster speed.

FLIGHT READY – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

MARTINI BLUE – Slow to muster speed.

RACE 5 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1650 METRES)

MONTEZULU – Raced three-wide throughout.

EMMJAY (NZ) – Raced four-wide throughout.

AMERICAN JEWEL – Raced wide with cover throughout.

KITTY PURRING – Stewards spoke to rider C. Van Munster regarding the abrupt manor in which she shifted out to obtain clear running at the 100 metres, resulting in her mount covering extra ground.

RACE 6 – OLIVE TREE CATERING MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (2100 METRES)

HAPPY CLAN – Fractious is barrier. Jumped out making contact with NAVAJO WARRIOR. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected.

NAVAJO WARRIOR – Bumped by HAPPY CLAN at the start. Caught wide until the 1200m. Hung out in the home straight. Stewards queried rider C. Baker regarding the tactics adopted on the gelding. Rider C. Baker stated that the gelding was up in class today and in her opinion failed to handle the track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

AFRIDI (NZ) – Raced three-wide with cover in the middle stages.

RACE 7 – CAMPBELL TOWN HOTEL MOTEL BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP – (1200 METRES)

HOT RELATION – Slow to muster speed. Stewards queried rider S. Carr regarding the performance of the gelding. Rider S. Carr stated that she was caught wide early, was back further than anticipated and the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the home straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

THELMA – Raced three-wide middle stages.

INTISAR – Slow to muster speed.

JEHBENTI – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after receiving attention from the oncourse farrier and was passed fit to race. Reared on jumping, slow to muster speed.

RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1100 METRES)

NOT RICH ENUFF – Returning to racing after fractured pedal bone. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. Tendency to over-race in the middle stages

FEAR THE STING – Fractious in the barrier. Over-raced middle stages.

WHIZ BY – Raced wide early.

MIRA FLORES – Raced wide early.

ARAYA SUNSHINE – Tendency to over-race in the early stages. Momentarily held up at the 400m before shifting out rounding the home turn to improve position.

GEE GEES CHORIS – Raced wide early.
